## APPLICATION INFORMATION FOR TWO \$1000 SCHOLARSHIPS SPONSORED BY ALLEY-WHITE AMERICAN LEGION AUXILIARY UNIT 52

Alley-White American Legion Auxiliary Unit 52 is accepting applications for two \$1000 general continuing education scholarships beginning February 15, 2009. All graduating high school seniors who reside in Baxter County, including those who are home-schooled, are eligible to apply. Letters of application MUST be received by the scholarship committee no later than April 15, 2009.

In the letters, students must include personal information regarding the colleges they are considering and proof that one of their parents or grandparents is a veteran, or that they currently have a relative on active duty in the United States Armed Forces. The DD214 discharge document is preferred, but other proof will be accepted. The award must be used within one year.

### PERSONAL INFORMATION SHOULD INCLUDE:

- Name, age, complete address and home phone number
- Both parents' names and occupations
- Number of sibling residing in the home
- Career path the student wishes to pursue
- Schools being considered for attendance
- Relationship to the veteran

### SCHOLASTIC INFORMATION:

- Copy of student transcript that includes Grade Point Average, SAT scores & ACT scores
- Letter of recommendation from a teacher or school official
- Extracurricular activities & awards

### COMMUNITY SERVICE

- Involvement in community projects
- Volunteering / helping others

Students chosen to receive a scholarship will be requested to supply the American Legion Auxiliary with the name and address of where their award is to be sent. Once the student has registered for classes, he or she will need to contact the Auxiliary Treasurer, sending proof that registration has taken place. At that time a check for \$1000 will be sent to the school. This award can be used toward

tuition, books or supplies. If not used for this purpose, the money will be returned to the American Legion Auxiliary. No refunds will be given to the student.
