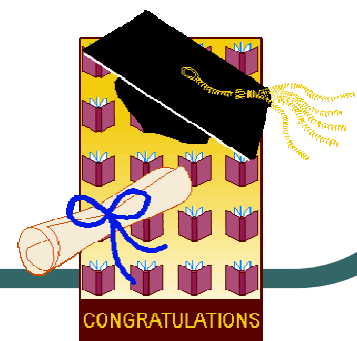

Admins' Corner

What Travelers Really Want from Airlines

A recent survey was completed by 3,200 US travelers. These travelers were asked dozens of questions about their travel preferences, on a range of topics from airline fees to in-flight Wi-Fi. Below are the results.

Lobbying for Legroom. 25% travelers say limited legroom is the biggest grip about air travel. When asked what could the airline do to make the in-flight experience better, 30% say more legroom and 38% requested roomier seats.

No More Fees. In the past year, nearly every major air carrier has either added or raised fees for amenities including checked baggage and in-flight services. It is no surprise then that 25% of respondents consider airline fees to be their biggest complaint about air travel. The most annoying airline fee? 56% say that would be the checked baggage fee.

Traveler's Airline Fee Forecast. 31% predicted new "seat selection fees". 31% also believed airlines would add peak date surcharges for top travel dates, such as holidays.

Size Does Matter. 74% of respondents think passenger size should be required to purchase tickets for two seats on their flight.

Wi-Fi in the Sky. 30% of travelers say they would be more likely to book a flight with in-flight Wi-Fi than one without. 61% say they would be unwilling to pay for in-flight Wi-Fi access. 27% say they would be willing to pay \$5 or less for this service.

Carry-On-Commotion. 58% bring a carry-on bag to avoid extra fees. 62% say they would put their carry-on over someone else's seat if their overhead space was already full. 57% believed that each seat should have assigned space in the overhead compartment even if it meant that carry-ons had to be smaller.

Other Results. 73% said a little small talk with seatmates is fine, but prefer to keep to themselves most of the flight. 52% of fliers prefer aisle seats, 44% prefer the window. 33% of respondents request exit row and 13% ask for bulkhead. 95% of respondents think there should be a price limit on bottled water post-security at the airport since security checkpoints do not allow passengers to pass through with their own.

Early-bird registration is open for this year's [Education Forum and Annual Meeting](#) in Boston July 18-21. Don't miss a fantastic EFAM with even more education.

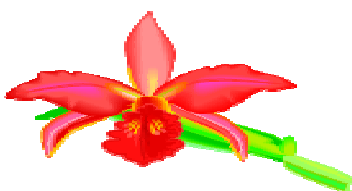
EFAM gets started July 18 with the Sunday business session followed by the Evening of Welcome. This year we have a grand slam of a party planned for attendees.

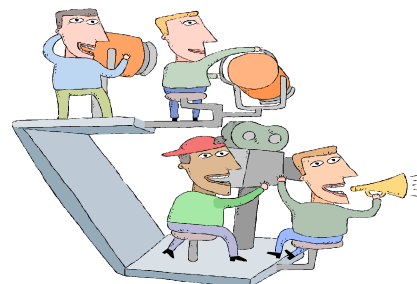
