- ✓ Play from Blue Tees (Women from Red, Seniors from Gold, optional).
- ✓ All players in group tee off.
- ✓ The best shot is then selected and all players bring their ball to that point.
- ✓ All players hit their next shot from that point, placing their ball within six inches, no closer to the hole; continue until the green is reached.
- ✓ On the green, all players putt from the point selected, placing their ball within six inches, no closer to the hole.
- ✓ If one player lags putt close to the hole, do not putt out, as the score will count. All players must have a chance to make the putt before putting out.
- ✓ In case of a tie, winners will be determined by matching cards on holes predetermined by the committee.
- ✓ This format is designed for fast play, please keep the pace and don't fall behind the group in front of you.
