16th Annual Glenn Packard Tournament Rules

1. Play from Blue Tees - Ladies from Red - Seniors from Gold optional
2. All players in the group tee off.
3. Over the course of 18 holes, each team must use each player's tee shot a minimum of 2 times.
4. The best shot is then selected and all players bring their ball to that point.
5. All players hit their next shot, placing the ball within a club's length, no closer to the hole; continue until the green is reached.
6. On the green, all players putt from the selected point, placing the ball within six inches, no closer to the hole
7. If one player lags putt close to the hole, do not putt out, as the score will count. All players must have a chance to make the putt before putting out.
8. In case of a tie, winners will be determined by matching cards on holes predetermined by the committee.
9. This format is designed for fast play, please keep the pace and don't fall behind the group in front of you.
