



Advice on Your Trees – Almost Free!

If you have trees planted on your property in Norwalk, ask yourself the following questions:

Do I know

- The exact species of each?
- The approximate age of each?
- The approximate life expectancy of each?
- How healthy each tree is?
- If they need pruning or spraying?
- When and with what it should be sprayed?
- If my trees have invasive roots?
- Are my trees too close together to thrive?
- If these species do well in this climate and my soil?
- How big will they get and how fast will they grow?

The Norwalk Tree Alliance can arrange a detailed survey and give you a written report *on any two of your trees*. The survey will be conducted by a licensed arborist and an experienced volunteer member of the Norwalk Tree Alliance. Survey opportunities are limited, so call early for an appointment. A tax deductible donation of \$50 to the Norwalk Tree Alliance is suggested.

Your donation will be of significant help to the Norwalk Tree Alliance in covering its operating expenses. The Tree Alliance is a U.S. Govt. registered 501(c) (3) non-profit organization of Norwalk volunteers helping to make our city beautiful.
