Dan Kehoe opened the meeting with an announcement that the Guidelite 911 units can and will be returned to the vendor after the public reaction at the "Suffield on the Green" was minimal. We will keep a few units on hand and can reorder units as needed if the program takes off in the future.

This evening's program was a presentation by Michael Bangser, Executive Director of the Hartford Foundation for Public Giving. Mr. Bangser outlined the role of the organization as a non profit facilitator of monies donated in the Greater Hartford area. With strong ties to Suffield benefactors in the names of families such as Bissell, Fuller, Zak, Packard and others, we have been lucky to receive many benefits from the organization. Grants such as the Zak Foundation to the Suffield Library, the Grand Piano (Christine's Piano!) in the Suffield High Performing Arts Center, the Technology lab at the library and other programs owe their existence to this organization.

Non-Profit organizations are facing 3 major challenges, 1. Public funding is down in this economy, 2. Private funding is down as the stock market recovers and 3. the need for non-profit services rises in this time of need. The Hartford Foundation helps donors connect to their community by fostering links to achieve the donor's goals. The foundation also helps communities by funneling available money to the organizations in need.
