

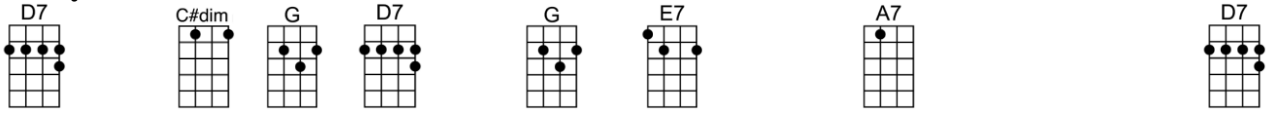

[I want to go back to my lit-tle grass shack in Ke-ah-la-ke-kua, Ha - wai - i.



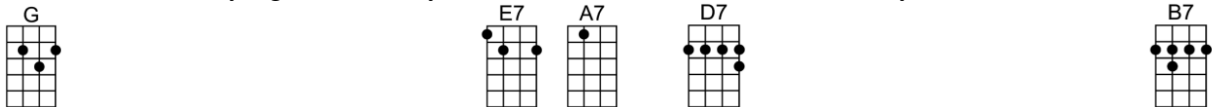
I want to be with all the kah-nees and va-hee-nees that I knew long a-go.



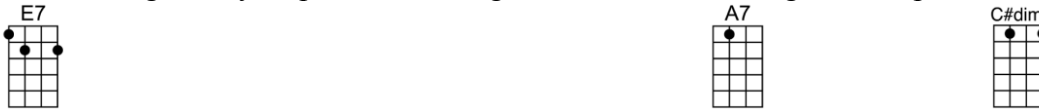
I can hear the old gui-tars a play-ing on the beach at Ho-oh-now-now.
