LORD BALTIMORE INCREASES SCHOLARSHIP FUNDS BY 50%

Lord Baltimore Lions Club increased the amount of our scholarship awards from \$1,000 to \$1,500 per year, thanks to the support of the local community. This year's awards reflected a tight contest among the five applicants from all graduating seniors at Indian River High School. There was only a 10-point spread among the candidates, all of whom were among the top 10 in their class.

The winner of the 4-year scholarship is Molly Ann Benner of Bethany Beach, who plans to have Occupational Therapy as her major. Jocelyn Hazzard of Ocean View won the 1-year scholarship and will pursue a Marketing degree.

Scholarships from the Lord Baltimore Lions Club are awarded annually to students who live in the Lord Baltimore Elementary School area and attend the Indian River High School. A team of five LB Lions review anonymous applications and rate each student primarily on academic, financial need and extra-curricular activities. Only the Scholarship Chairman, Lion Jim Beck, knows the identities of the applicants but does not participate in the scoring.

This year's winners will be honored during our June 3rd Dinner Meeting at Magnolia's Restaurant.
