1. You will fill in your form identifying your UFO's along with the date you started it and what inspired you to make it a project.
2. Then decide which project you want to do first and in what order.
3. Bring your project to Sew & Tell at each meeting and we will note you completed your UFO.
4. We will start with showing our completed UFO's at our February meeting and go through November.

There will be a prize for the person or person's who complete the most UFO's by November.

P.S. Even if you only have 4-5 UFO's, please join in the fun.

I found my UFO list from 2008 and I only completed 3 of 8 in the end, but it was enough encouragement to get at least those done.

There are UFO's you don't think you'll ever complete. You know the ones – make a **decision** what to do with them – put it to the QuiltFest Sale Table, give it to someone that will finish them, throw it away (hopefully not) or whatever, just make a decision.

Bring your list with you to the January meeting so you can complete your form. You have until the February meeting to sign up.
