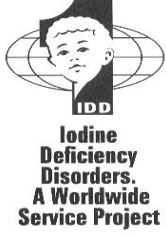

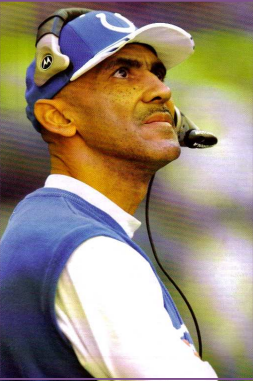

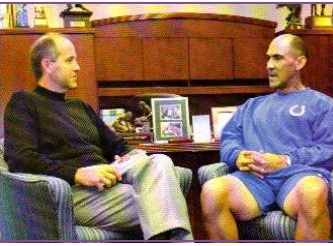
Casting the VISION
