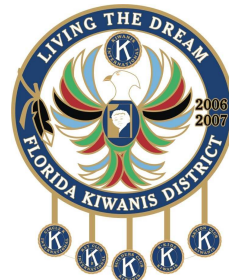
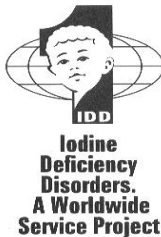

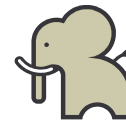

JIM COOK

We were pleased to welcome Coach **JIM COOK** to our breakfast meeting last week, January 9. Coach **COOK** had last spoke to us in November, 2004, when we first learned of his legendary career as a collegiate and youth soccer coach for well over 20 years.

Originally from Ohio and graduate of Bowling Green State University with a Math and Science Major, **JIM COOK** has been a teacher, instructor, engineer and coach as well as a city planner and a Chamber of Commerce executive officer.

The organization that **JIM** is part of now is called "ikick". His coaches take children as young as 3 and teach them the fundamentals of soccer. He hires professional coaches to teach these youngsters the skills and techniques of soccer. The coaches do not emphasize winning and losing, but rather the skills of the game and team work.

One of the difficulties being faced by the coaches today is discipline. Young people, watching sports, are seeing behaviors that they are modeling. As young as five years old, soccer players are spitting and pushing each other. It is the responsibility of parents to do the disciplining, but sometimes, **JIM** observes, they want to do the coaching instead.



JIM's passion is providing "life" training for kids, teaching them how to play soccer as well as how to deal with adversity. He is committed to training as many kids as he can.

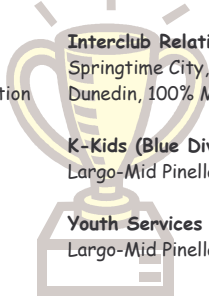
