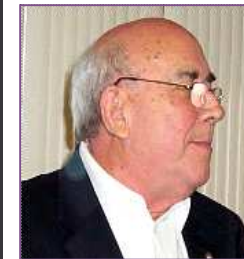

Founding President **GEORGE HARDIN** was clearly beaming with pride as he began the Anniversary Program introducing **BOB BAKER**, first Secretary of Countryside Kiwanis who served for three years. **BOB** described the founding of the club on December 5, 1975, and the Charter night on January 28, 1976.

**GEORGE** jokingly said Countryside Kiwanis saved the July 4th Midnight Run fundraiser after Dunedin Kiwanis sponsored Countryside as a new club and then asked for assistance with the Midnight Run so that the Run became a joint project along with Morton Plant Mease Hospital.

**GEORGE** then went on to extol the many accomplishments and projects taken on by Countryside Kiwanis including the Midnight Run, the Countryside High School Stadium (the largest project ever by one Kiwanis club), Iodine Deficiency Disorder (IDD) project in which Kiwanis International has raised \$91,000,000 over the years, Club awards including Best Newsletter in the Florida District, best Young Children Priority One (YCP1) reading to 10 Head Start children classes each week, best Key Club sponsor, twelve Ralph Davis and seven Hixson Awards, \$1,000 each and assisted with the formation of three Kiwanis clubs.
