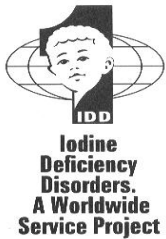

Pictured above are Dr. **ROBERT A. STUBBINS**, receiving a plaque as the Clearwater Free Clinic 2007 physician of the Year and **JEANNE SHAPIRO**, Clinic Executive Director, visiting our breakfast meeting on Tuesday, February 5.

Dr. **STUBBINS**, now 83, told a fascinating story of his experiences as a doctor in a small town in the Canadian province of Saskatchewan. After high school, having paid \$95.00 which he earned doing many odd jobs and with a \$100 scholarship, he set off on a train, not previously ever having been on one, to the University of Saskatchewan located in the town of Saskatoon, honoring his mom's wish that he become a doctor.

As a young medical student, Dr. **STUBBINS** elected to serve for 5 years in a remote area of the province, some 120 miles from the nearest city, in order not to pay for tuition fees. The doctor he was replacing told him he was going to have to do dentistry, test eyes and serve as the coroner of the area.

For 5 years starting in 1944, Dr. **STUBBINS** worked out of an 8-bed hospital under the most primitive conditions and looking back, concluded he "saved a few lives and didn't kill anybody."
