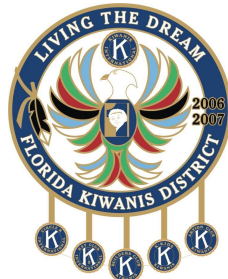
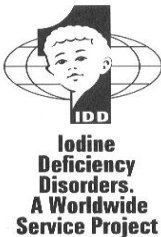

summary of his talk at our break-  
fast meeting last week, February 20.

Today, I spoke about the Penny for Pinellas, the  
upcoming vote for renewal, and gave some facts about the  
current Penny and what is in store for the future. I men-  
tioned some of the projects that the Penny has taken on in  
the Oldsmar and Countryside areas as well as some projected  
projects pending the renewal such as roadway beautification,  
improvements to the Mobbly Bay Wilderness Preserve, a  
Countryside Recreation Center, the restoration of the Olds-  
mar Bank Building among others.

The main purpose of the presentation today was to  
provide some extra information and to create an awareness  
of the good the Penny for Pinellas has done throughout the  
county and its municipalitites. I stressed that the Penny is  
not a new tax - that it has been in place since 1990 and that  
this upcoming vote is a vote for renewal for the years 2010-  
2020; that it adds value to our county and benefits our econ-  
omy by funding many of our capital projects without relying  
on property taxes; that it is paid by anyone who spends money  
in the county, including a very large portion (about a third of  
total funds) from the strong flow of tourists to this area  
every year; that it gets divided between the county and the  
cities; that it can **ONLY** be used for capital improvements;  
and that it is not collected on our  
necessities (groceries and medica-  
tions).
