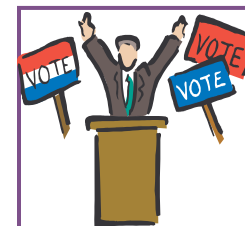
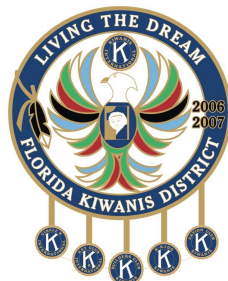
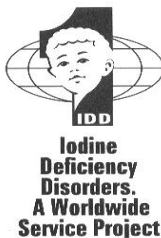

We are indebted to **Dr. ERNIE PANZA**, retired Chiropractic Physician, Speaker, Author and Coach, our guest speaker last week, May 8, for furnishing a summary of his remarks:

I stands for **INTELLIGENCE**, it doesn't take a rocket scientist to understand that a civic club needs individuals who are intelligent enough to take on the challenge of a project and make it a success.



S stands for **SENSITIVITY**, you have to be sensitive to people's needs and wants as are Kiwanians. You need to be sensitive to club members and people in the community. This to me is what **KIWANIS** stands for."
