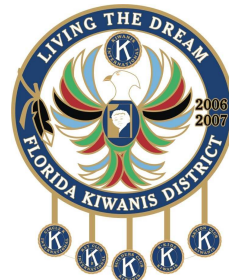
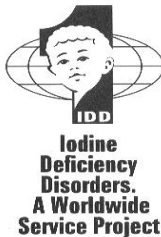

We are indebted to **CHRISTINE WASHICK**, owner with husband, **AL**, of Acme Locksmith in Oldsmar, our guest speaker last week, May 22, for furnishing a summary of her remarks:

"Acme Locksmith has served the Tampa Bay area for nearly 40 years and I've been a part of it for the last 11. We are a full-service locksmith offering mobile service to your home or business. Commercial work includes restricted, high-security master-key systems, access control, door closers, exit bars, safe sales and service. Key bumping, also called lock bumping has been in the local news over the past several months. This is a technique used to open standard locks. Information is readily available on the internet to anyone interested. My recent search on google.com (I typed in "bump key") yielded a video showing exactly how to make and use a bump key. As I write this summary (Friday, 5/25) that same video has now been viewed over 300,000 times. I also found out that bump keys can be purchased on-line.

At Acme, we recommend Medeco high-security locks. These patented locks are bump-proof. In addition, key duplication is restricted. Our store is located in the County Line Plaza which is at the southeast corner of Tampa and Race Track Roads. We're open Monday thru Friday, 8:30 til 5:00. Need I mention that at Acme we make keys that work."
