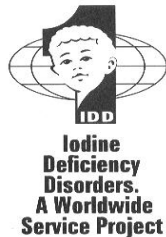

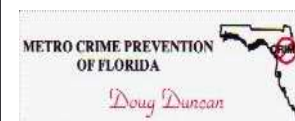

Indeed, **DOUG** stated he wanted to help us to "become "street smart" because when you are "street smart" you are not a target." He went on to say when you are not a target, you don't have to worry about becoming a victim. He stressed there is a problem with computers when they are not shut down when they are not being used. Most of us it seems, don't like to wait for our computers to warm up when turned on so as a consequence they are left on when not being used. **DOUG** revealed that there is a device, that can be pointed toward a person's home when the computer is on that will enable a person to be into that computer fully and completely.

He provided information about scams including the neighborhood gas station, how to protect your home when you are not there, using only deadbolt locks with keys that have many ridges, leaving only the ignition key when having your car serviced and using sequenced lighting when away from home.

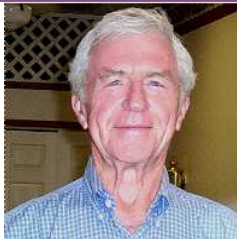
