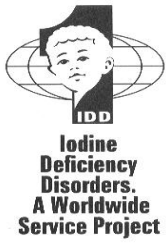

**OUR DAY AT CAMP**

"Our day started in sunshine and wound up with rain. **NORA STACKPOLE** and I went to **JAN HORN's** Blooming Place for Kids summer camp in the Bradenton area yesterday. Speaking of sunshine, **JAN** certainly provides that in the lives of the kids attending the camp for a few weeks in the summertime.

"The kids are pretty well behaved for having been abused and neglected most or all of their lives. All of them live with foster parents or relatives since their parents are mostly in jail. One youngster still had welts on his back like he had been whipped, which he had been with wire cable we were told. The father had also hit him with a baseball bat. The boy was very quiet as you might imagine but did participate in camp activities.

"We were struck by the lovely verdant foliage surrounding the cabins, dormitories, the main hall and the chapel on the grounds. **JAN** and her staff of counselors run a tight ship with precise scheduling of activities through the day. **NORA** performed her "magical feats" of physics after the kids had canoed and swam in the pool. Later, we had lunch at their main hall before **JAN** took us on a brief tour.

"**DICK** and **JEN LUCE** also made the trip to camp and enjoyed seeing first hand what **JAN's** mission in life is all about. **JAN** is the epitome of the Kiwanis spirit in serving the children of our area. She is a definite asset to Kiwanis and to humanity. We're proud to support her charity, to have her as a member of our Countryside Kiwanis Club and to call her our friend."
