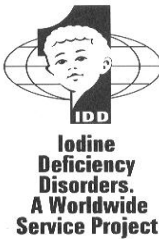

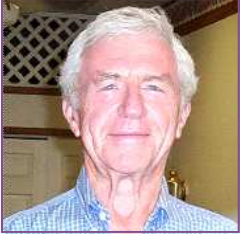

STUART HARRIS

STUART HARRIS has a passion. A passion to reach kids to become responsible citizens. **STUART** believes in the "village". He does not feel that the schools have much of a chance with kids who come to school with no manners, have no communication skills, whose parents have never read to them. "It is hard for the schools to do anything in that situation .

Hence **STUART's** interest in the Challenge Day program. In a nutshell, he revealed in this program 100 kids thought to have influence on other kids are taken for one day to place in a school, usually a gym. They could be Key Club members or even gang leaders. These are made to interact with 20 adult volunteers over the course of an entire day.

Among the exercises used is "crossing the line" where the kids are lined up on one side of the gym at a "masking tape" line. The kids are then invited to cross the line when a profile of a kid is called out such as "have you ever been discriminated against because of the shape of your body or because of your color" The kids are made to come face to face with what hurts their fellow students. Much emotion is expressed by the kids during this day long event.

Much preparation is required putting on a Challenge Day including having the school and prominent members of the community as part of the team. **STUART** is also concerned that while schools teach every craft, parenting is not one of them. He feels it is the responsibility of parents as to whether a child lands in jail or become a responsible citizen.
