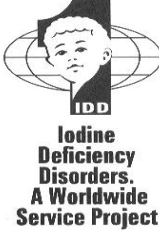

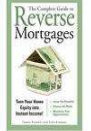

Back in 1999, **WILBER**, a CPA, discussing the sad state of ethics in business and the professions with a stockbroker friend, felt compelled to do something about it. Within three months **WILBER** spearheaded the formation of a Committee which led to the Florida Association for the Restoration of Ethics, Inc.

The Association's brochure tells it all, "The Florida Association for the Restoration of Ethics, Inc. (FARE) was founded in August, 1999, by a group of Clearwater business and professional people who wanted to raise the level of understanding and commitment to the basic, moral values that this country once stood for. The Association promotes such ethical standards as fairness, integrity, honor, responsibility and respect".

WILBER related that it has been an uphill fight ever since the Association was founded, first to define ethical behavior which could be as simple as "doing the right thing" or from the Bible, the Golden Rule, do unto others as you would have others do unto you". And then to combat the notion, "because everybody else does it", as an explanation of unethical behavior.



The Association offers a plan, at no cost, to members of area Chambers of Commerce that includes among other steps, Consultation with a FARE member, sample Codes of Ethics, sample one-page statements of Ethical principles and assistance in implementing Codes of Ethics and Standards
