Dear Korean War Veterans:

I am Do Young Kim, General Secretary of FAVKW.

How have you been? I wish you happy and healthy.

Time is coming closer for us to have the 2010 Appreciation Event in honor of the Korean War American Veterans at Las Vegas again. We have been preparing to give all participating veterans the most memorable and joyful day with appreciation dinner and ceremony, superb music, and war-story telling programs, etc.

Now I like to ask you as follows:

1) To those veterans who gave us their RSVP and personal information, I have already sent the information for the hotel reservation. But I am afraid that some of the veterans did not receive the information I sent. If you know anyone who hasn't received or if you have anyone who wants to attend the event, please give them the hotel reservation information and send us their name, and address and telephone No.

2) At Appreciation Concert on June 13, we need four or more veterans of each of four US militaries: Army, Air force, Navy and Marine Corps. The veterans as a team will come up on the stage with their colors and sing their own song with the band. (Rehearsal with the band will be at the Orleans Hotel 2:00-5:00 on June 13) Interestingly, there will be a big competition among Army, Navy, Air force and

Marine corps for the military songs. It will be First come, first serve. Whoever wants to sing, please contact us as soon as possible.

3) In the morning session of June 14 (Monday) we will have a war-story telling program with personal memory or experience of the Korean War. For this, we like to ask any participant to contact as soon as possible, if he wants to do it at this program. Due to the time constraint, we will accept only 15-20 persons on the basis of the first come, first serve. Each person will be allowed to speak 5 minutes. If you want to speak, please send us the title, if any, and your own written story itself via email or mail. We like to print some of the stories on our Appreciation Event Brochure. If there are many stories, we plan to edit and publish all of them as a book too.
