From the President

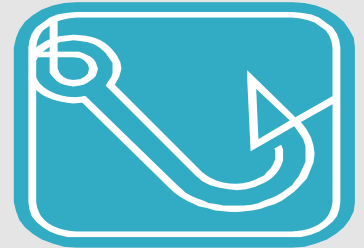
ASMC Members,
