Fifty years ago in 1962, a Club member, Ed Wells, Jr. organized the first meet. Over these many years, Ed raised hundreds of thousands of dollars to resurface the track and maintain the track facilities and equipment. In 2005, the entire track was rebuilt to world class and Olympic standards valued at \$250,000. Ed's vision and personal commitment to accomplish this for Clearwater High School and our Clearwater community is remarkable. In 2006 Jim Ewbank became the Meet Director. Jim is a retired Clearwater High and Pinellas County school administrator and past Club President. Springtime City Kiwanis Club is honored to continue Ed's legacy - hosting Pinellas County's and Florida's best high school invitational track meet.
