All Welsh are invited, whether a puppy who has never seen a bird, or a seasoned hunting dog. They will all have opportunities for birds, guns if ready, swimming, and training ideas. For those who might be considering entering the WSSCA hunt test Nov. 13/14 this is the location and it's a great opportunity to familiarize your dog with the pond and fields that might be used at the test.

While it's fine if you decide at the last minute to join the fun, it will help me with the planning, if you email me and let me know you are coming, and a few things about your dog (s)' experience.

1. **Has your dog been shot over?**
2. **Has your dog been introduced to birds? Quail? Chucker?**
3. **Do you have certain skills you'd like to work on?**

Things to bring:

1. **Item of blaze orange (vest/cap)**
2. **whistle (if you have one)**
3. **check cord (if you have one..or a 25 foot flexi lead is ok)**
4. **water for your dog**
5. **Towel for your dog after the pond**

We plan to use quail, however if your dog has never been on chucker and you're considering the hunt tests, let me know and I'll try also to arrange for some chucker or pheasant.

These days are always fun because there's always something to learn from each dog, no matter the level.
