Danielson Earns Second Player Of The Week Honor

Sophomore Kanani Danielson was named Western Athletic Conference Volleyball Player of the Week for the week of Sept. 3-13. It was her second honor of the season and the third of her career. The sophomore outside hitter tallied 34 kills, 19 digs and seven blocks over three matches en route to earning Most Outstanding Player honors at the Honolulu Advertiser Volleyball Challenge.

Danielson averaged 3.78 kills with a .466 hitting percentage as she led Hawai'i to the tournament title with wins over Weber State (3-0), UT-San Antonio (3-0) and No. 10 Stanford (3-0). Danielson had 13 kills and hit .455 against No. 10 Stanford in the championship match. She also hit a career-high .625 against UT-San Antonio with 10 kills on 16 attempts without an error.

Three Named To Volleyball Challenge All-Tournament Team

UH had three players earn all-tournament honors following the Honolulu Advertiser Volleyball Challenge. Sophomore Kanani Danielson was named Most Outstanding Player, her second MOP award this year. Danielson averaged 3.78 kills and 2.11 digs per set and hit .466 over the three matches. Senior Amber Kaufman earned her first all-tournament team selection this year and the second of her career. Kaufman hit .590 over the three matches and averaged 3.25 kills per set. Dani Mafua earned her second all-tournament team selection, averaging 12.33 assists, 1.33 digs and 1.11 blocks per set.

UH Records Program's 1,000th Win

UH's victory over Stanford on Sept. 12 was the program's 1,000th victory since playing a Division I schedule in 1974. The Rainbow Wahine have won four national titles in that span and participated in 27 NCAA Tournaments. Head Coach Dave Shoji has recorded 991 of the 1000 wins at UH. Overall UH's record is 1000-176-1 (.850) in 36 years.

UH Ranked No. 4 In AVCA Poll; No. 4 In Volleyball Magazine

The Rainbow Wahine moved up two spots in this week's AVCA Top 25 Coaches Poll. UH is ranked No. 4 in the AVCA Coaches Poll and also moved up to No. 4 in the Volleyball Magazine Poll. The Rainbow Wahine moved up two spots from No. 6 last week, after sweeping No. 10 Stanford at home to improve to 7-2 on the season. UH faces No. 25 Pepperdine this week at home. Hawai'i has enjoyed a successful run of 254-consecutive weeks in the AVCA Coaches Poll.

Hawai'i also has appeared in 383 of the 387 (.989) polls all-time. UH is third in poll appearances, behind only Nebraska and Stanford, who have both appeared in all 387 polls.

Hawai'i also ranks third to Stanford and Nebraska in weeks ranked in the top 10 (292) and rank third to Nebraska and UCLA in weeks ranked at No. 1 (48). In its 48 weeks as the No. 1 team in the country, UH boasts a 126-10 (.923) record.

Strong Hitting Performance

The Rainbow Wahine had their best hitting performance of the year in the Honolulu Advertiser Volleyball Challenge. UH hit .422 over the three matches, including hitting a season-high .500 against UT-San Antonio. UH's second highest hitting percentage of the year came against No. 10 Stanford, when UH hit .392 for the match, including 51 kills in three sets. On the year, UH is hitting .301, averaging 14.12 kills per set.

Kaufman Ties Career High

Senior Amber Kaufman tied a career-high with 13 kills against No. 10 Stanford. Kaufman tied her career-high earlier this season with 13 kills against No. 25 Santa Clara in the second match of the year. Against Stanford on Sept. 12, Kaufman had 13 kills on 17 attempts and just one error, hitting .706 in the match. Over three matches in the tournament, Kaufman hit .590 and had 26 kills, averaging 3.25 kills per set.

Danielson Hits For Career High

Kanani Danielson had a near perfect hitting night against UT-San Antonio on Sept. 11 during the second match of the Honolulu Advertiser Volleyball Challenge. Danielson had 10 kills on 16 attempts with no errors in the three-set match. Danielson hit a career-high .625 for the match, which also including six digs and four blocks.

National Ranks

As a team the Rainbow Wahine rank seventh in the country in hitting percentage at .301 overall, rank 16th in kills per set, averaging 14.13 and rank 10th in assists per set at 13.31. Individually, Amber Kaufman ranks seventh in hitting percentage at .460 on the year. Dani Mafua ranks seventh in assists per set at 11.75 and Brittany Hewitt ranks ninth in blocks per set, averaging 1.52. Aneli Cubi-Otineru ranks 11th in aces per set at 0.59 and Kanani Danielson ranks 45th overall in kills per set at 4.03.

Cubi-Otineru Named To Wahine Classic All-Tourney Team

Senior outside hitter Aneli Cubi-Otineru was named to the Hawaiian Airlines Wahine Classic All-Tournament team following last weekend's matches. Cubi-Otineru averaged 2.46 kills, 2.23 digs and 1.00 blocks against No. 2 Texas, No. 10 California and No. 19 Saint Louis. The all-tournament marks the second straight week Cubi-Otineru was named to an all-tournament team and is the second year in a row she was named to the Wahine Classic all-tournament team.

Ferrell Tops Last Week's Career Night

A week after having a career night, sophomore Stephanie Ferrell set two career-highs against No. 10 California on Sept. 6. Ferrell recorded 18 kills, surpassing her 14 kills against UCLA on Aug. 30. Ferrell also had nine digs in the match, surpassing her eight kills she against UCLA. Ferrell hit .256 for the match and had one ace against Cal.

Five Straight Ranked Opponents

UH finished a stretch of five matches with all five opponents being ranked in the AVCA Top 25 Coaches Poll. The Rainbow Wahine went 3-2 over that stretch, including wins over No. 9 UCLA, No. 19 Saint Louis and No. 25 Santa Clara. UH lost two matches last week to No. 2 Texas and No. 10 California.

15th Annual Volleyball Challenge

UH won their 13th Volleyball Challenge in the 15 years it has been hosted at UH. The Rainbow Wahine went 3-0 in the tournament, beating Weber State, UT-San Antonio and No. 10 Stanford in the championship match. UH didn't drop a set all weekend, including a 3-0 victory over Stanford.

Fans Fill Up Stan Sheriff Center

For UH's game against No. 2 Texas on Sept. 5 at the Stan Sheriff Center, the crowd of 8,657 was the largest crowd to watch the Rainbow Wahine since the 2006 NCAA Regional Final against UCLA. It was also the largest regular-season crowd since Nov. 18, 2005 against Louisiana Tech.

Ferrell Comes Up With Career Night Against No. 9 UCLA

Sophomore outside hitter Stephanie Ferrell had a career match against No. 9 UCLA on Sunday, Aug. 30. Ferrell recorded 14 kills and eight digs, both career highs. Ferrell had four kills in the first set and five kills in sets 2 and 3. Her previous career-high was 13 kills set last season against Wyoming.

Kaufman Unloads On No. 25 Santa Clara

Senior middle Amber Kaufman hit a career-high .765 against No. 25 Santa Clara on Saturday, Aug. 29. Kaufman tied a career-high with 13 kills, which came on 17 attempts and no errors in the match. Over the weekend, Kaufman hit .426, averaging 2.4 kills per set and had four aces.

Aces Wild For Cubi-Otineru

Senior outside hitter Aneli Cubi-Otineru combined for 12 aces over three matches, including tying a career-high five aces twice. Cubi-Otineru served five aces against No. 9 UCLA on Aug. 29 and two nights earlier served five aces against Western Michigan. She had two aces against No. 25 Santa Clara in between. She averaged 1.20 aces per set over the weekend.

Freshman Hewitt Breaks Out

Redshirt freshman Brittany Hewitt showed UH fans what she has been working on over the past year. Hewitt recorded a double-double with 10 kills and 11 blocks in just her second match of her career against No. 25 Santa Clara on Aug. 29. Hewitt hit .467 with 10 kills in 15 attempts and added 10 block assists and one solo block against the Broncos. Hewitt followed up the Santa Clara match with four kills and five blocks against No. 9 UCLA. After her first weekend of competition, Hewitt averaged 1.67 kills and 2.00 blocks per set.

Kaufman Versus Hooker, On The Court

The last time Amber Kaufman and Destinee Hooker were together in the same competition, it wasn't on the volleyball court. Hooker is the top outside hitter for No. 2 Texas, while Kaufman is the top middle for No. 4 Hawai'i. But in June, the two were in the finals of the NCAA Outdoor Track and Field Championships in Arkansas. Hooker won the NCAA Championship, while Kaufman finished in third. This will be the first meeting between the two on the volleyball court.

UH Players Named All-Tourney; Danielson MOP

Kanani Danielson was named the Most Outstanding Player of the Chevron Rainbow Wahine Invitational, following UH's sweep of the tournament. Senior Aneli Cubi-Otineru and junior Dani Mafua were named all-tournament. UCLA Amanda Gil and Lauren Cook were joined by Santa Clara Krista Kelley and Western Michigan's Michelle Moore to round out the team. This is the second tournament Danielson has been named MOP, including last season's Honolulu Advertiser Challenge. Last year Danielson and was also named to the Chevron Rainbow Wahine Invitational all-tournament team.

Danielson Named WAC Player of the Week

Sophomore outside hitter Kanani Danielson was named WAC Player of the Week for the week of Aug. 24-30. This is the first WAC Player of the Week honor of the season for Danielson and the second of her career.

The sophomore outside hitter tallied 54 kills, 19 digs and 11 blocks over three matches en route to earning Most Outstanding Player honors at the Chevron Rainbow Wahine Invitational. Danielson averaged a league-best 5.40 kills on .408 hitting as she led Hawai'i to the tournament title with wins over No. 28 Western Michigan, No. 25 Santa Clara and No. 9 UCLA.

Danielson, who led the Rainbow Wahine in kills in all three matches, tied a career high with 22 kills against Santa Clara. She also tied her career high with five blocks against both Santa Clara and Western Michigan. In the final match of the week against UCLA, Danielson hit .414, posting 16 kills in three sets.

Hawai'i In The Chevron Rainbow Wahine Invitational

The Rainbow Wahine won the Chevron Rainbow Wahine Invitational for the fourth time in the first five years of the tournament. UH won the inaugural tournament in 2003 and then again in 2004. After the tournament wasn't played for two years, UH came back and won the tournament in 2008. The Rainbow Wahine are 11-2 all-time in the tournament.

Rainbow Wahine Picked to Win 14th Straight WAC Title

UH was selected in a poll by the WAC's coaches to defend its crown in 2009 and take home its 14th-straight WAC regular-season title.

The Rainbow Wahine received eight of the nine first-place votes with New Mexico State earning the other first-place vote. Hawai'i earned 64 total points followed by New Mexico State with 57. Utah State was picked to finish third with 45 points, followed by Idaho in fourth with 41 points. Nevada was picked fifth with 37 points, while Fresno State was selected sixth with 29 points, just ahead of San Jose State with 28 points in seventh place. Boise State and Louisiana Tech rounded out the poll with 12 and 11 points, respectively.

Hawai'i won their ninth-straight WAC tournament title last season, advancing to all 11 championship matches. They have also won 13-straight WAC regular season titles, as they have won all conference regular season titles since joining the WAC in volleyball in 1996. The Rainbow Wahine have a record of 186-4 (.978) in conference play.

UH had an amazing streak of 114-consecutive wins in conference play that ran from Oct. 17, 1998 to Oct. 13, 2006, when the Rainbow Wahine fell to New Mexico State in five games in Las Cruces, N.M. The streak spanned seven years and 361 days, beating 17 different teams. The loss occurred on the 58th road match during the streak, on the 29th different road trip that the Rainbow Wahine had taken.

Danielson Named WAC Preseason Player Of The Year

The Preseason all-WAC volleyball team, as voted on by the nine head coaches, features five UH players, including sophomore Kanani Danielson, who was named WAC Preseason Player of the Year.

This is the fifth-straight season that a Rainbow Wahine player has earned the pre-season honor with All-Americans Kanoe Kamana`o (2005, 2006) and Jamie Houston (2007, 2008) each earning the honor in back-to-back years.

Hawai'i placed the most student-athletes on the 12-player team with five. Along with Danielson, seniors Aneli Cubi-Otineru and Amber Kaufman, junior Dani Mafua and sophomore Stephanie Ferrell earned preseason honors. Cubi-Otineru and Kaufman were all first-team all-WAC selections in 2008, while Mafua was a second-team pick and Ferrell was on the All-Freshman Team.

Nevada placed two players on the preseason team in juniors Lindsay Baldwin and Kylie Harrington, as did New Mexico State with seniors Krista Altermatt and Kelli Goodan. Utah State also had two selections in juniors Chelsea Fowles and Christine Morrill. Senior Anna McKinney of Idaho rounded out the preseason squad.

Five teams placed at least one player on the preseason all-WAC team. Five players are returning first-team all-WAC honorees, while five student-athletes are returning second-team picks.

This Week in Rainbow Wahine History

Sept. 20, 1996 - In Uh's first year against WAC competition, Hawai'i Head Coach Dave Shoji picked up WAC win No. 1 and career victory No. 600 on the same night, sweeping Fresno State. The team went on to the NCAA Championships before falling to Stanford in the national title match.

Sept. 18-19, 1979 - The Rainbow Wahine open the 1979 season with two, straight-set wins over Pittsburgh. Hawai'i would go on to win the first team national championship in school history later that season, defeating Utah State in the AIAW National Championship match.

Sept. 16-17, 1982 - Coming off a 37-3 season that abruptly ended at the NCAA Regionals, Hawai'i opens the 1982 season with straight-set wins over Cal State Chico and UH-Hilo. The Rainbow Wahine would go on to a 33-1 record that year, winning their first NCAA title.

Sept. 16, 2000 - UH beats UNLV 15-0, 15-12 and 15-3, marking the last time Hawai'i was able to hold a team scoreless in game. With the advent of rally scoring, it is also likely to be the last time ever that the Rainbow Wahine will accomplish that feat.

HEAD COACH DAVE SHOJI

Dave Shoji has been a mainstay in both the realm of athletics in Hawai'i and in the volleyball community for the past 35 years. As Shoji is primed to become just the second women's volleyball coach in NCAA Division I history to reach 1,000 career victories this season, the legendary coach still remains one of the best in the country, leading his team to 14 consecutive conference titles and appearances in 10 of the last 11 NCAA regionals.

The honors have piled up for Shoji over the years. He is a nine-time conference and region Coach of the Year and was named the national Coach of the Year in 1982. Shoji was named to the list of all-time great coaches by USA Volleyball in 2002. He has also been inducted into Hawai'i Sports Hall of Fame and was named coach of the NCAA 25th Anniversary team.

In 1975, a young Shoji took over the reins of the UH women's volleyball program. He was just 28 years old with no clue that he would turn a one-year-old program into a national powerhouse for the next three decades.

The team was coming off a 9-1 campaign in 1974 that ended with the Rainbow Wahine falling to UCLA in the national title match at the AIAW Championship.

In Shoji's first four years at the helm of the program, he took the team to two more national title matches before he finally broke through to take the title in 1979 with a five-game victory over Utah State in the AIAW finals.

It was the school's first-ever team national championship and a sign of great things to come for the young program.

In 1981, Shoji became UH's first full-time coach for a women's program. He led the team to another national title, this time in the new NCAA Tournament in 1982, beating the USC Women of Troy in a come-from-behind five-game thriller.

Shoji would lead the team to another title in 1983 with a straight-set win over UCLA, becoming the first school to win back-to-back NCAA championships.

The Rainbow Wahine again returned to the national championship match in 1987, capping a 37-2 season with a sweep of Stanford for the program's fourth national title and third NCAA title.

The team lost to Texas in the 1988 national championship match, then went through a stretch of five frustrating losses in six years to rival Long Beach State in the NCAA Regionals, holding them out of the NCAA Championships.

UH looked primed to return to the final four in 1995, going through the season undefeated at 29-0. After winning their regional match over Arizona State, Hawai'i was set for a national championship run. But Michigan State dealt a heart-breaking blow to those plans, coming back from being down two games to none, to hold the Rainbow Wahine out of the NCAA Championships.

Hawai'i would finally make that return in 1996, dropping just one set in the first four matches of the NCAA Tournament. But another long-time nemesis of the Rainbow Wahine, Stanford, stopped UH's bid for a national title, sweeping Hawai'i in the championship match.

The Rainbow Wahine experienced another great run of success that started with the 1998 season, as transfer Heather Bown led the team from a perennial Top 25 squad and NCAA Tournament team to again a national-title contender.

Hawai'i made its way to the NCAA Regional Final in 1998 and was one of the top seeds in the 1999 tournament before a scrappy Texas A&M team beat UH in the regionals.

Following that season, Louisiana-native Kim Willoughby came to the program, joining Lily Kahumoku, who was already establishing herself as one of the best players in the country, to form a dynamic duo that would lead the team to great success for another four years. From 2000-03, the Rainbow Wahine advanced to the NCAA Championship national semifinal match three times, while Shoji's 2003 senior class became the winningest class in school history.

Under Shoji, UH volleyball finished in the Top 10 in 22 of the 27 final AVCA polls, and ranked in the top five 14 times. They have made it to the post-season in all but one year, finishing with a winning record in all 34 seasons.

The 63-year-old was also responsible for the start of the men's volleyball program in 1978. Shoji served as the men's coach at UH from 1978-85, compiling a record of 81-48, leading the team to a Western Collegiate Volleyball Conference title in 1980.

Shoji was a three-sport athlete at Upland High School in California, playing football, basketball and baseball. He then moved on to UC Santa Barbara, where he played baseball for a year, along with three years of volleyball. He earned All-America honors as a volleyball player in 1968 and '69. He earned his bachelor's degree in physical education in 1969.

After spending two years in the U.S. Army, Shoji returned to Hawai'i to coach the Kalani High School girls' and boys' volleyball teams. He then took an assistant coaching job at Punahou School.

Shoji and his wife, the former Mary Teneffos, reside in Manoa. They have three children. Cobey, 30, works at Stanford University. Kawika, 20, and Erik, 18, play for the Stanford men's volleyball team.

Scouting the Waves

Pepperdine comes into the week ranked No. 25 in the latest AVCA Coaches Poll rankings and carries a 7-2 record. The Waves are coming off a home weekend where they went 2-1, with wins over Seattle and UC Riverside and a loss to Army. Pepperdine will face No. 7 UCLA at home on Wednesday, before heading out to the islands to face UH.

The Waves beat No. 24 Colorado State to open the season and lost at No. 26 USC for their two matches against ranked teams. Pepperdine is led by Lilla Frederick, who is averaging 3.27 kills and 2.13 digs per set. Rachel Grochmal is averaging 2.66 kills and 2.83 digs per set and libero Stevi Robingson is averaging 5.40 digs per set.

UH holds a 24-3 all-time advantage over Pepperdine with the last meeting coming in 2006, when the Waves visited the Stan Sheriff Center for two back-to-back matches. UH won both tight matches, going five in each match.
