Mr. 1,000

Head Coach Dave Shoji became just the second NCAA Division I women's volleyball coach to reach the 1,000 victory milestone with a win over New Mexico State on Oct. 17, 2009. A near sell-out of 9,293 fans showed up to witness the memorable night at the Stan Sheriff Center. Shoji now has 1,001 victories all-time.

Fans Come Out For Shoji

On Saturday, Oct. 17, the Stan Sheriff Center was filled with 9,293 fans for Dave Shoji's 1,000th victory. Saturday's match was the highest attended match since the 2006 NCAA Regional Final against UCLA, which drew 9,572 fans. It was also the highest regular season match since 2004, when 9,875 fans showed up for a match against Nevada on Nov. 13.

Aneli Aces

In two matches last week, senior outside hitter Aneli Cubi-Otineru was on fire from behind the service line. Cubi-Otineru had seven aces in two matches, including four against New Mexico State and three against Louisiana Tech. On the season, Cubi-Otineru has a team-leading 37 aces. She also ranks seventh in the country in aces per set, averaging 0.59.

WAC Midway Point

With eight matches in WAC play under their belt, the Rainbow Wahine have hit the halfway point. UH has won eight straight matches to start WAC play and will play six of its final eight WAC matches on the road. As a team UH leads the conference in hitting percentage, opponent hitting percentage, assists, kills and aces. Individually, Amber Kaufman leads the WAC in hitting percentage (.481), Dani Mafua leads in assists (11.38) and Aneli Cubi-Otineru leads in aces (0.68).

Kaufman Goes Perfect

Senior middle Amber Kaufman had a perfect night against Louisiana Tech. In just two sets, Kaufman had eight kills on eight swings with no errors, hitting a perfect 1.000. Kaufman's previous career-high in hitting percentage came earlier this season when she hit .765 against Santa Clara.

UH Ranked No. 3 In AVCA Poll; No. 4 In Volleyball Magazine

The Rainbow Wahine remain at No. 3 in this week's AVCA Top 25 Coaches Poll and moved to No. 4 in the Volleyball Magazine Poll. The Rainbow Wahine have won 13-straight matches, including wins over New Mexico State and Louisiana Tech last week. Hawai'i has enjoyed a successful run of 259-consecutive weeks in the AVCA Coaches Poll.

Hawai'i also has appeared in 388 of the 392 (.989) polls all-time. UH is third in poll appearances, behind only Nebraska and Stanford, who have both appeared in all 392 polls.

Hawai'i also ranks third to Stanford and Nebraska in weeks ranked in the top 10 (298) and rank third to Nebraska and UCLA in weeks ranked at No. 1 (48). In its 48 weeks as the No. 1 team in the country, UH boasts a 126-10 (.923) record.

Eight Straight 3-0 Wins

The Rainbow Wahine won eight straight matches by a 3-0 score, ending against New Mexico State on Oct. 3, when UH won in four sets. UH started the streak against Weber State on Sept. 10, and have beat No. 10 Stanford and No. 25 Pepperdine (twice) by the score of 3-0. On the season, UH has won 13 matches overall by a 3-0 score.

The University of Hawai'i Athletics Department will no longer disclose any medical information regarding student-athletes. This has been implemented to protect the privacy of the student-athletes in accordance with the Family Educational Rights and Privacy Act (FERPA) and the Health Insurance Portability and Accountability Act (HIPAA). Information on each student-athlete will be released as "probable," "questionable" or "doubtful."

National Ranks

As a team the Rainbow Wahine rank fifth in the country in hitting percentage at .299 overall. Individually, Brittany Hewitt ranks third in the nation in blocks per set at 1.54 and Amber Kaufman ranks sixth in hitting percentage at .432 on the year. Dani Mafua ranks 14th in assists per set at 11.52 and Aneli Cubi-Otineru ranks seventh in aces per set at 0.59.

UH Carries 13-Match Win Streak

The Rainbow Wahine come into the week having won 13-straight matches, including their first eight WAC matches. UH has only dropped two sets during the win streak, winning 39 out of 41 sets played. The Rainbow Wahine won four straight matches to begin the year, before dropping two in a row, but bounced back with 13 straight wins.

Kaufman Records Career High

Senior middle blocker Amber Kaufman had a career-high 15 kills against Nevada on Oct. 8. Kaufman had 15 kills on 20 swings and one error, hitting .700 for the match. Kaufman had 13 kills twice earlier this season to tie a then career-high.

All-Around For Danielson

Kanani Danielson had two all-around performances against Nevada and San Jose State. Danielson had 23 kills, 10 digs and seven blocks in six sets played over the two matches. She averaged 3.83 kills, 1.67 digs and 1.17 blocks per set. Danielson also tied a career-high with five blocks against San Jose State on Oct. 9.

Strong Two Sets For Hewitt

Against San Jose State Oct. 9, redshirt freshman Brittany Hewitt had an impressive two sets. Hewitt had eight kills on 10 swings with one error, hitting .700. Hewitt also had six blocks, including one solo block. Her numbers came in the first two sets, sitting out the final set of the match.

Danielson Records 21 Kills

Kanani Danielson had 21 kills at New Mexico State, one shy of her career-high on Oct. 3. Danielson finished the match with 21 kills on 41 attempts and five errors, hitting .390. Danielson had five kills and five errors on 12 swings after the first set. The next three sets, she had 16 kills on 29 swings and no errors.

Danielson Earns Third WAC Player Of The Week Honor

Sophomore outside hitter Kanani Danielson has been named WAC Player of the Week for the week of Sept. 28-Oct. 4. It's the third WAC Player of the Week honor of the season for Danielson and the fourth of her career.

The sophomore outside hitter averaged 4.00 kills on .379 hitting, 4.64 points, 1.71 digs and 0.43 service aces in a pair of wins last week. In a sweep of Louisiana Tech, Danielson recorded a career-high three service aces. She then posted a match-high 21 kills at New Mexico State to lead the Rainbow Wahine to the win, making them the only remaining undefeated team in WAC play.

In a pivotal third set against the Aggies, with UH trailing 22-21, Danielson recorded the final four points of the set with three straight kills and a solo block to help UH win the set 25-22. The team then cruised to a 25-11 victory in the fourth and final set.

UH Picks Up First Two Road Wins

The Rainbow Wahine traveled off island for the first time this season and came away with two road wins. UH played its first 13 matches at home, before taking a two-match road trip for WAC play. UH beat Louisiana Tech 3-0 on Oct. 1 and New Mexico State 3-1 on Oct. 3.

Rainbow Wahine Record 12 Blocks

For the second time this season, UH has recorded 12 blocks as a team. The Rainbow Wahine had 12 blocks against New Mexico State on Oct. 3. The 12 blocks are the second most this season, behind 14 blocks against Santa Clara on Aug. 29. UH also recorded 12 blocks against Pepperdine on Sept. 18.

Mafua Sets The Way

In two matches against Boise State and Idaho, junior setter Dani Mafua set the offense to a .399 hitting percentage and tied a couple career highs along the way. Mafua tied a career-high with four kills against Idaho on Sept. 26, hitting a perfect 1.000 on four attempts and tied a career-high with five blocks in the match. Over the two matches, Mafua averaged 11.33 assists, 1.00 kills, 1.33 digs and 1.33 blocks per set.

Mixing It Up

Against Boise State on Sept. 24, the Rainbow Wahine had a different starting lineup for the first time this season. Without sophomore outside hitter Kanani Danielson, sophomore Corinne Cascioppo made her first start of her career. Cascioppo had two kills, two digs and three blocks in the match. Senior defensive specialist Jayme Lee also made her first start of the season, recording four kills in the win.

Cubi-Otineru Named WAC Player Of The Week

Senior outside hitter Aneli Cubi-Otineru was named WAC Player of the Week for the week of Sept. 14-20. It was the first-ever WAC Player of the Week honor for Cubi-Otineru. The senior tallied 18 kills, 20 digs, five blocks and three service aces in back-to-back sweeps of No. 25 Pepperdine.

Cubi-Otineru averaged 3.00 kills, 3.33 digs, 0.83 blocks and 0.50 service aces to lead the Rainbow Wahine to their fourth and fifth straight victories. In the second match, she was one kill shy of a double-double, finishing with nine kills and 12 digs.

UH Records Program's 1,000th Win

UH's victory over Stanford on Sept. 12 was the program's 1,000th victory since playing a Division I schedule in 1974. The Rainbow Wahine have won four national titles in that span and participated in 27 NCAA Tournaments. Head Coach Dave Shoji has recorded 999 of the 1008 wins at UH. Overall UH's record is 1008-176-1 (.850) in 36 years.

Danielson Earns Second Player Of The Week Honor

Sophomore Kanani Danielson was named Western Athletic Conference Volleyball Player of the Week for the week of Sept. 3-13. It was her second honor of the season and the third of her career. The sophomore outside hitter tallied 34 kills, 19 digs and seven blocks over three matches en route to earning Most Outstanding Player honors at the Honolulu Advertiser Volleyball Challenge.

Danielson averaged 3.78 kills with a .466 hitting percentage as she led Hawai'i to the tournament title with wins over Weber State (3-0), UT-San Antonio (3-0) and No. 10 Stanford (3-0). Danielson had 13 kills and hit .455 against No. 10 Stanford in the championship match. She also hit a career-high .625 against UT-San Antonio with 10 kills on 16 attempts without an error.

Three Named To Volleyball Challenge All-Tournament Team

UH had three players earn all-tournament honors following the Honolulu Advertiser Volleyball Challenge. Sophomore Kanani Danielson was named Most Outstanding Player, her second MOP award this year. Danielson averaged 3.78 kills and 2.11 digs per set and hit .466 over the three matches. Senior Amber Kaufman earned her first all-tournament team selection this year and the second of her career. Kaufman hit .590 over the three matches and averaged 3.25 kills per set. Dani Mafua earned her second all-tournament team selection, averaging 12.33 assists, 1.33 digs and 1.11 blocks per set.

Strong Hitting Performance

The Rainbow Wahine had their best hitting performance of the year in the Honolulu Advertiser Volleyball Challenge. UH hit .422 over the three matches, including hitting a season-high .500 against UT-San Antonio. UH's second highest hitting percentage of the year came against No. 10 Stanford, when UH hit .392 for the match, including 51 kills in three sets.

Danielson Hits For Career-High

Kanani Danielson had a near perfect hitting night against UT-San Antonio on Sept. 11 during the second match of the Honolulu Advertiser Volleyball Challenge. Danielson had 10 kills on 16 attempts with no errors in the three-set match. Danielson hit a career-high .625 for the match, which also including six digs and four blocks.

Cubi-Otineru Named To Wahine Classic All-Tourney Team

Senior outside hitter Aneli Cubi-Otineru was named to the Hawaiian Airlines Wahine Classic All-Tournament team following last weekend's matches. Cubi-Otineru averaged 2.46 kills, 2.23 digs and 1.00 blocks against No. 2 Texas, No. 10 California and No. 19 Saint Louis. The all-tournament marks the second straight week Cubi-Otineru was named to an all-tournament team and is the second year in a row she was named to the Wahine Classic all-tournament team.

Ferrell Has Career Night

A week after having a career night, sophomore Stephanie Ferrell set two career-highs against No. 10 California on Sept. 6. Ferrell recorded 18 kills, surpassing her 14 kills against UCLA on Aug. 30. Ferrell also had nine digs in the match, surpassing her eight kills she against UCLA. Ferrell hit .256 for the match and had one ace against Cal.

This Week in Rainbow Wahine History

Oct. 20-22, 1977 - UH hosts Long Beach State for three matches, starting a long-time rivalry between the schools. Hawai'i beats the Beach in all three matches (all three being three game sweeps). The two teams would go on to meet 36 more times over the years with Long Beach State elimination Hawai'i from the NCAA Tournament five times in the late-80s and early-90s. UH holds a 22-25-1 overall lead against the Beach, taking the last meeting in a memorable five-game match in the 2000 NCAA Regionals, still the last meeting between the two.

Oct. 21, 1988 - Hawai'i head coach Dave Shoji takes his team on the road for a pair of non-conference matches at Wyoming and Colorado State. Shoji's Rainbow Wahine beat Wyoming 15-6, 15-9 and 15-9 for his 400th career victory. The team would go on to the NCAA title match before falling to Texas.

Oct. 20-21, 1989 - Hawai'i takes their first-ever trip to Lincoln, Neb., to face the Huskers, who had been establishing themselves as a Midwest powerhouse. UH sweeps the Cornhuskers in the first match before falling in four games the following night. Hawai'i would return to Lincoln in 2002, beating the Cornhuskers in four games in the NCAA Regional Final to make it to the NCAA Championships.

Oct. 21, 1994 - The Rainbow Wahine christen the new Special Events Arena with a four-game victory over San Jose State. The arena, which would later be rededicated as the Stan Sheriff Center, after former Athletics Director Stan Sheriff, has been the home of UH arena sports ever since, as the four arena sports (men's and women's volleyball and basketball) have combined 592-150 (.798) record in the facility.

Oct. 22, 1987 - Hawai'i's Diana Jessie gets nine kills on 10 attempts vs. Western Kentucky, posting a school record .900 hitting percentage. The record would hold for five years before Kenyatta Lovelace posted the only "perfect" match in UH history, a 12-for-12 night vs. Cal State Fullerton on Oct. 3, 1992.

Oct. 24, 1999 - Hawai'i faces Stanford in front of a sold-out Stan Sheriff Center. The second-ranked Rainbow Wahine get swept by the No. 7 Cardinal for UH's first loss of the season. Stanford was led by senior All-American Kerri Walsh and freshman Logan Tom.

HEAD COACH DAVE SHOJI

Dave Shoji has been a mainstay in both the realm of athletics in Hawai'i and in the volleyball community for the past 35 years. Shoji became just the second women's volleyball coach in NCAA Division I history to reach the 1,000 career victories milestone on Oct. 17, 2009. The legendary coach still remains one of the best in the country, leading his team to 14 consecutive conference titles and appearances in 10 of the last 11 NCAA regionals.

The honors have piled up for Shoji over the years. He is a nine-time conference and region Coach of the Year and was named the national Coach of the Year in 1982. Shoji was named to the list of all-time great coaches by USA Volleyball in 2002. He has also been inducted into Hawai'i Sports Hall of Fame and was named coach of the NCAA 25th Anniversary team.

In 1975, a young Shoji took over the reins of the UH women's volleyball program. He was just 28 years old with no clue that he would turn a one-year-old program into a national powerhouse for the next three decades.

The team was coming off a 9-1 campaign in 1974 that ended with the Rainbow Wahine falling to UCLA in the national title match at the AIAW Championship.

In Shoji's first four years at the helm of the program, he took the team to two more national title matches before he finally broke through to take the title in 1979 with a five-game victory over Utah State in the AIAW finals.

It was the school's first-ever team national championship and a sign of great things to come for the young program.

In 1981, Shoji became UH's first full-time coach for a women's program. He led the team to another national title, this time in the new NCAA Tournament in 1982, beating the USC Women of Troy in a come-from-behind five-game thriller.

Shoji would lead the team to another title in 1983 with a straight-set win over UCLA, becoming the first school to win back-to-back NCAA championships.

The Rainbow Wahine again returned to the national championship match in 1987, capping a 37-2 season with a sweep of Stanford for the program's fourth national title and third NCAA title.

The team lost to Texas in the 1988 national championship match, then went through a stretch of five frustrating losses in six years to rival Long Beach State in the NCAA Regionals, holding them out of the NCAA Championships.

UH looked primed to return to the final four in 1995, going through the season undefeated at 29-0. After winning their regional match over Arizona State, Hawai'i was set for a national championship run. But Michigan State dealt a heart-breaking blow to those plans, coming back from being down two games to none, to hold the Rainbow Wahine out of the NCAA Championships.

Hawai'i would finally make that return in 1996, dropping just one set in the first four matches of the NCAA Tournament. But another long-time nemesis of the Rainbow Wahine, Stanford, stopped UH's bid for a national title, sweeping Hawai'i in the championship match.

The Rainbow Wahine experienced another great run of success that started with the 1998 season, as transfer Heather Bown led the team from a perennial Top 25 squad and NCAA Tournament team to again a national-title contender.

Hawai'i made its way to the NCAA Regional Final in 1998 and was one of the top seeds in the 1999 tournament before a scrappy Texas A&M team beat UH in the regionals.

Following that season, Louisiana-native Kim Willoughby came to the program, joining Lily Kahumoku, who was already establishing herself as one of the best players in the country, to form a dynamic duo that would lead the team to great success for another four years. From 2000-03, the Rainbow Wahine advanced to the NCAA Championship national semifinal match three times, while Shoji's 2003 senior class became the winningest class in school history.

Under Shoji, UH volleyball finished in the Top 10 in 22 of the 27 final AVCA polls, and ranked in the top five 14 times. They have made it to the post-season in all but one year, finishing with a winning record in all 34 seasons.

The 63-year-old was also responsible for the start of the men's volleyball program in 1978. Shoji served as the men's coach at UH from 1978-85, compiling a record of 81-48, leading the team to a Western Collegiate Volleyball Conference title in 1980.

Shoji was a three-sport athlete at Upland High School in California, playing football, basketball and baseball. He then moved on to UC Santa Barbara, where he played baseball for a year, along with three years of volleyball. He earned All-America honors as a volleyball player in 1968 and '69. He earned his bachelor's degree in physical education in 1969.

After spending two years in the U.S. Army, Shoji returned to Hawai'i to coach the Kalani High School girls' and boys' volleyball teams. He then took an assistant coaching job at Punahou School.

Shoji and his wife, the former Mary Tennefos, reside in Manoa. They have three children. Cobey, 30, works at Stanford University. Kawika, 20, and Erik, 18, play for the Stanford men's volleyball team.
