• RESTAURANT NIGHTS

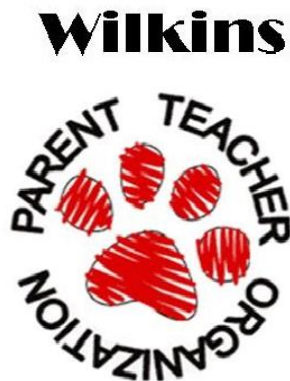
