PLAYER RULES AND REGULATIONS**



1. All entrants must be 21 or over.
2. Teams shall consist of four players and one designated driver which may play each hole if desired.
3. Designated Drivers will not be permitted to consume any alcoholic beverages during the tournament, but will receive soft drinks from participating businesses, a T-shirt, and be eligible for any prizes their team wins. Should the Designated Driver consume any alcoholic beverage, he/she and the rest of the team will be disqualified immediately.
4. Designated Drivers are responsible for transporting his or her team from “hole to hole” **AND TRANSPORTATION OF THE TEAM HOME FOLLOWING THE AWARDS.**
5. Entry fee is \$175.00 per team, with all proceeds going to Bannock Civitan to help persons with disabilities and underprivileged children in our area.
6. The “course” shall consist of local businesses, each designing and building the holes” inside their establishment. A total of 18 holes will be played. A listing of holes and a map will be provided at registration.
7. Each team is responsible for giving their scorecard to the Civitan Judge at each hole to record their scores, and for getting their cards turned in promptly at the end of play. The team score will be the lowest player’s score for each hole. Your scorecard should have only the best score per hole listed. Judges **MUST** record the score, not the players.
8. Players must supply their own putter and ball.
9. Each team is limited to no more than 15 minutes per hole, and please move on to the next hole when done to keep things running smoothly.
10. The first 60 teams (300 players) to sign up (and pay!) will receive a T-shirt! Along with the 1st, 2nd, and 3rd place team prizes, there will be a **nice prize for the best (or worst) dressed team.** All awards and prizes will be handed out at Center Street Clubhouse as soon as all teams are in and scored.
11. Check-in begins at the Center Street Clubhouse at 8:30 a.m. Saturday the 25th, judges will be at the bar between 9:30 and 9:45 a.m. and play will begin promptly at 10:00. A team representative must check in at Center Street to pick up a scorecard, find out your starting point, and ask any questions you may have.
12. A judge will be at each hole to rule on any questionable shots and his/her decision is **FINAL.** **ONLY** Judges will record scores on scorecards.
13. In the case of a tie on total scores, a putt-off will be held at the Center Street Clubhouse, one player from each team will be involved to putt-off one hole.

15. All teams will return score cards immediately to the Center Street Clubhouse after the final round. Failure to return cards in a timely manner may disqualify your team.

NOTE: Drinks cannot be carried from bar to bar.
