1. To achieve Blue Chip

- b. These items will be identified with an "*" and *italicized* print
- c. Chapter organization must achieve Year End Growth

2. Blue Chip Parade

- a. Optional items to be completed to increase a Chapters point value in the Blue Chip Parade ranking
- b. These items will be identified with a number
- c. If the Chapter organization is not at Year End Growth they will be ranked after all at growth chapters regardless of the point totals achieved

3. Items identified with a "✓" require verification to be sent
