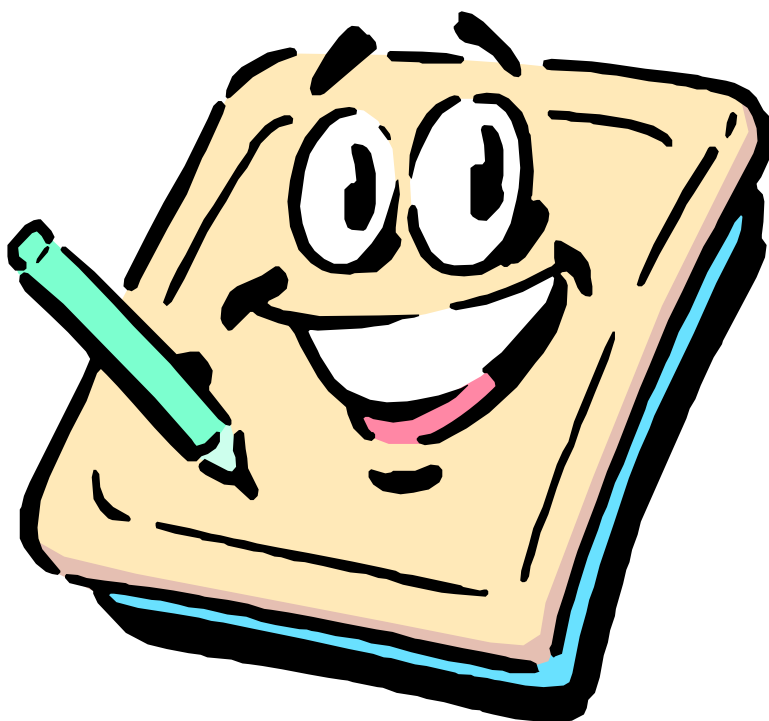

## General Activities

### Butterfly Candy

- What you need: Candy sticks white floral wire or pipe cleaners, pink cardstock/construction paper, white pom-pom, craft glue. Fold paper in half and cut out a pair of butterfly wings. Decorate wings with dots of glitter glue. Let glue dry. Twist the center of a 2 1/2 - inch with around one end of the candy stick. Shape the ends into antennae/ Attach the wings to the candy stick with glue. Glue a pom-pom head to the candy stick near the antennae.

### Be mine Lollipop

- What you need: Yellow lollipop, yellow and black pom-pom. Black wire, silver sequins, ribbon or netting, red paper. For bees: cut wings from ribbon or netting. Glue a black and yellow pom-pom. Let glue dry completely. Cut a 6-inch wire. Spiral one end around the yellow pom-pom. Coil the remaining wire around the lollipop stick. Cut a message strip from rep paper. Glue one end around the lollipop stick.

### Corn popper party favors

- What you need: Sugar ice cream cone, candy corn, orange tissue paper, tape, white floral tape, yellow ribbon. Start with sugar ice cream cones. Fill each one with candy corn pieces or other candies. Wrap three layers of orange tissue paper tightly around at wide end. Trim excess. Secure with tape. Make a white tip by wrapping white floral tape around point end. Attach a yellow ribbon where tissue and tape meet.

### Ghost Sucker

- What you need: 10 inch square of white fabric, paper towel or tissue, Tootsie Roll Pop suckers, ^ inch ribbon (any color) Direction: Place sucker in the center of the fabric. Gather the fabric around the stick just below the ball shaped candy (ghost's head). Tie a ribbon around the ghost's "neck". Draw ghost eyes on the fabric head with a marker.

## **Black cats**

- What you'll need: Cat pattern to trace, with a rectangular body and circular head. Double-sided tape 10 SNICKERS® Brand FUN SIZE® Bars 20 M&M'S® Brand Milk Chocolate Candies for Halloween 30 black pipe cleaners 10 orange pipe cleaners Black construction paper  
Direction: Trace the pattern onto the black construction paper and cut it out. Use the double-sided tape to attach the head to the body.
