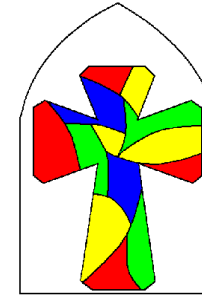

PURPOSE OF TRES DIAS

TRES DIAS is an adult weekend which aims to concentrate closely on the person and teachings of Jesus Christ.

While TRES DIAS explores the basic Christian beliefs, it is best described as a spiritual encounter with Christ. Those who attend a weekend experience a deeper and more meaningful relationship with Christ as they see and feel His love in a dynamic way. They then carry His love back into their many environments (family, church, work, etc.) to bring others to Christ.

WHAT HAPPENS ON A TRES DIAS WEEKEND?

The Spanish words "TRES DIAS" mean "THREE DAYS." The weekend begins on a Thursday evening and ends on the following Sunday evening.

During these THREE DAYS, the basics of the Christian life and the meaning of living a Christian ideal in our daily lives are presented.

TRES DIAS is centered on lay and clergy talks. The team leading the weekend is made up of laymen and clergy who have previously attended a TRES DIAS or similar weekend. They volunteer their time for weeks of preparation in work and prayer to build a Christian community that will minister to new attendees (called candidates) to TRES DIAS.

The atmosphere at a TRES DIAS weekend is one of love, joy, Christian fellowship, singing, laughing, and worship. It makes future Christian experiences more meaningful because it shows how lively and joyful the Christian life is intended to be.

TRES DIAS is made only once in a lifetime. But that one experience changes one's life forever.

WHO SHOULD ATTEND A TRES DIAS WEEKEND?

TRES DIAS is strictly an ecumenical movement. It is open to any Christian from any Christian denomination. It ignores denominational doctrines and presents the truth from God's Word. It is a tool of God to build up His church and prepare it to fulfill Christ's commission of taking the Gospel into all the world.

There are separate weekends for men and women. If married, husbands generally attend a weekend first. Wives usually attend a few weeks later. *Each person wishing to attend must be sponsored by someone who has previously attended a TRES DIAS or similar weekend.*

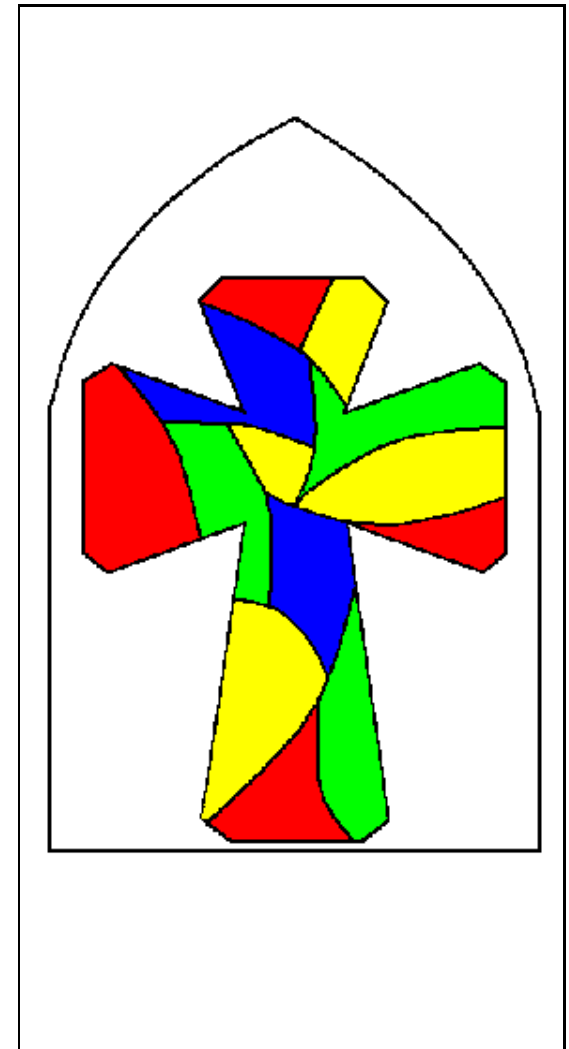
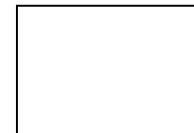
TRES DIAS STATEMENT OF BELIEFS

- A. We believe and profess our faith in one triune God, the Father, the Son, and the Holy Spirit.(Matthew 28:19)
- B. We believe and profess that Jesus Christ is the only Savior and is God in the flesh. (John 1:1, 3:16 and 14:6)
- C. We believe and profess that the Holy Spirit is God and is The Lord and Giver of Life. (Romans 8:11, Job 33:4)
- D. We believe and profess that the Holy Scriptures are the inspired and completely true Word of God. (II Timothy 3:16-17)
- E. We believe and profess that all have sinned and fallen short of the glory of God, that forgiveness of sins is received through confession and repentance, and that our sins are washed away through the blood of Jesus Christ. (Romans 3:23, Acts 2:38 and I John 1:9)
- F. We believe and profess that salvation is a gift of God's grace obtained through personal faith in Jesus Christ. (Ephesians 2:8)
- G. We believe and profess that the Body of Christ is to make every effort to keep the unity of the Spirit through the bond of peace until we all reach unity in the faith and in the knowledge of the Son of God. (Ephesians 4:3,13)
- H. We believe and profess that God's unconditional love, as made manifest to us through Jesus Christ, is the primary witness by which people are renewed, edified, and changed. (I Corinthians 13:8)
- I. We believe and profess that God has called us to live holy lives that will bring glory to His name. (Colossians 3:1-25)

HOW TO ATTEND A TRES DIAS

To attend a TRES DIAS weekend, complete this application. If married, separate applications for each spouse should be submitted at the same time. Once your portion has been completed, return the application(s) to your sponsor or, once obtaining the sponsor information and signature, mail to the address on this form.
