Communication is very important for a successful year. I welcome all parents into my office. If you have a concern or comment, please feel free to contact me.

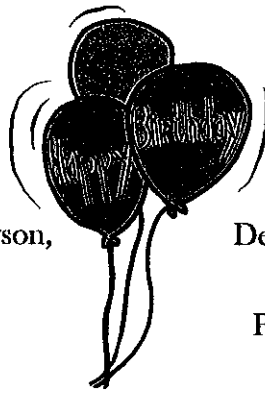
Remember, as parents and administrators, we have the same goal. We want each student on this campus to grow up to be a successful, productive citizen. Together we can reach this goal!

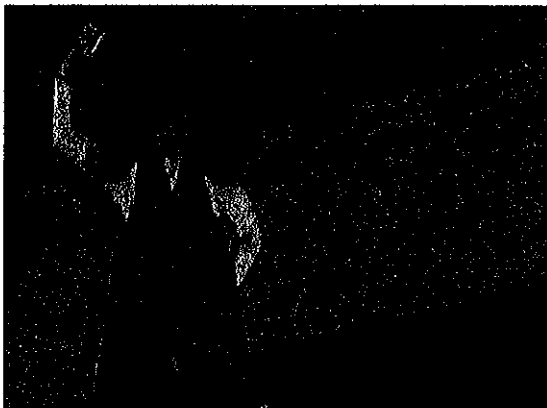

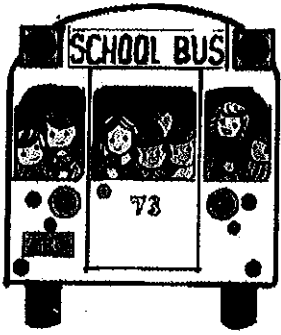

Oct. 26th & Oct 27th - Vision and hearing screening K, 1st, 3rd, 5th Grades

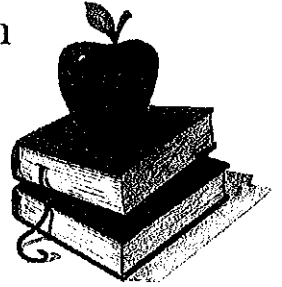
