Principal's Message October 2008

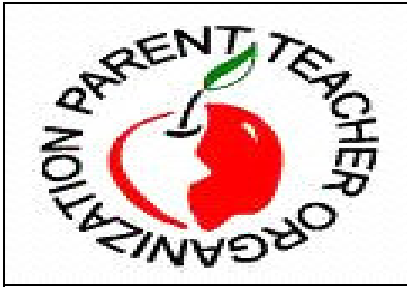

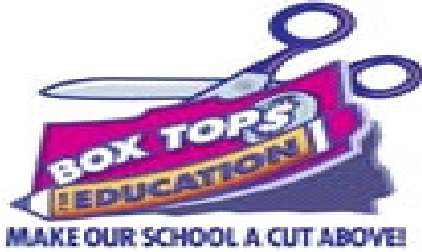
