<p>What is the most important part of the Liturgy of the Eucharist? (The consecration.)</p>	<p>What is the consecration? (It is when the priest, using the words of our Lord, changes the bread and wine into the Body and Blood of Christ.)</p>
<p>What reminds us of the Mystery of Faith during Mass? (The Memorial Acclamation.)</p>	<p>What rite helps us to confess our sorrow for any wrongdoing, knowing that God is there for us, ready to forgive? (Penitential Rite)</p>
