

THE TWENTY-SEVEN TEACHINGS

- 1. Repentance** – To be Godly sorry and turn away from wicked ways. (Mark 1:15; Luke 13:3; Acts 3:19)
- 2. Justification** – God’s act of forgiving sinners and declaring the righteous (Romans 5:1-9; Titus 3:7)
- 3. Regeneration** – New Birth (Matthew 19:28; Titus 3:5)
- 4. Born Again** – Spiritual rebirth. (John 3:3; 1 Peter 1:23; 1 John 3:9)
- 5. Sanctification Subsequent to Justification** – After being freed from guilt of sin you’ve been set apart and consecrated to do the work of God. (Romans 5:2; 1 Corinthians 1:30; 1 Thessalonians 4:3; Hebrews 12:14; 1 John 1:9)
- 6. Holiness** – Spiritually pure. (Luke 1:74-75; 1 Thessalonians 4:7; Hebrews 12:14)
- 7. Water Baptism** – A way of washing your sins (Matthew 28:19; Mark 1:8-10; John 22:23; Acts 8:12, 36-38; 10:47-48; 16:33; 19:3-5)
- 8. Baptism with the Holy Ghost Subsequent to Cleansing, the Eduement of Power for Service** – You can receive the gift of the Holy Ghost through baptism only after being cleansed of your sins after which you shall receive the power of the anointing. (Matthew 3:11; Luke 24:49-53; Acts 1:4-8)
- 9. The Speaking of Tongues as the Evidence of the Baptism with the Holy Ghost** – A gift you receive after being cleanse of your sins and filled with the Holy Ghost. (John 15:26; Acts 2:4; 10:44-46; 19:6)
- 10. The Full Restoration of the Gift to the Church** – The gift that have been restored to the church body. (1 Corinthians 12:1, 7-10, 28, 31; 14:1)
- 11. Signs Following Believers** – If you are a believer God will give you the power to overcome. (Mark 16:17-20; Romans 15:18-19; Hebrews 2:4)
- 12. Fruits of the Spirit** – You have to live by the fruits of the spirit in order to be a child of God. (Romans 6:22; Galatians 5:22-23; Philippians 1:11)
- 13. Divine Healing Provided for All in the Atonement** – On the Day of Atonement all sins are forgiven. (Psalm 103:3; Isaiah 53:4; Matthew 8:17; James 5:14-16; 1 Peter 2:24)
- 14. The Lord’s Supper** – Ritual sharing the body of Christ. (Luke 22:17-20; 1 Corinthians 11:22-23)

15. Washing the Saint's Feet – A sign of humility (John 13:4-17; 1 Timothy 5:10)

16. Tithing and Giving – God's financial gift of the Church. (Genesis 14:18-20; Genesis 28:20-22; Malachi 3:10; Matthew 23:23; Luke 11:42; 1 Corinthians 16:2; 2 Corinthians 9:6-9)

17. Restitution Where Possible – To restore back to its original owner (Matthew 3:8; Luke 19:8-9; Romans 13:8)

18. Pre-millennial Second Coming of Jesus

First: **To resurrect the dead saints and to catch away the living saints to meet Him in the air** (the Rapture) (Matthew 24:27-28; 1 Corinthians 15:21, 52; 1 Thessalonians 4:15-17)

Second: **To reign on earth a thousand years.** (Zechariah 14:4-5; Luke 1:32; 1 Thessalonians 4:14; Jude 14:15; 2 Thessalonians 1:7-10; Revelations 5:10; 19:11-21; 20:4-6)

19. Resurrection – The rising of Christ from the Dead (Isaiah 26:19; Daniel 12:2; John 5:28-29; Acts 24:15; Revelations 20:5-6)

20. Eternal Life for the Righteous – When you die in Christ, you live forever (Matthew 25:46; Luke 18:30; John 10:28; Romans 6:22; 1 John 5:11-13)

21. Eternal Punishment for the Wicked. No Liberation nor Annihilation – Final Judgment (Matthew 25:41-46; Mark 3:39; 2 Thessalonians 1:8-9; Revelations 20:10-15; 21:8)

22. Total Abstinence from All Liquor or Strong Drinking – Don't drink alcoholic beverages (Proverbs 20:1; 23:29-32; Isaiah 28:7; Galatians 5:21; 1 Corinthians 5:11, 6:10)

23. Against the Use of Tobacco in any Form. Opium, Morphine, etc. – Do Not Smoke (Isaiah 55:2; 1 Corinthians 10:31-32; 2 Corinthians 7:1; Ephesians 5:3-8; James 1:21)

24. Meats and Drinks – Let no one tell you what to eat or drink (Romans 14:2-3, 17; 1 Corinthians 8:8; 1 Timothy 4:1-5; Colossians 2:16-17)

25. The Sabbath – A time to rest (Hosea 2:11; Romans 12:1-2, 14:5-6)

26. Against Members Swearing – Don't swear, tell the truth (Matthew 5:34; James 5:12)

27. Against Divorce and Remarriage Evil – Marriage is a sacred sacrament which can be unbind by an adulteress spouse or death (Matthew 2:12, 5:32, 14:3-4; Mark 10:12; Luke 16:18; Romans 7:2-3; 1 Corinthians 6:9, 13, 16-18; 7:2, 10-11; Acts 15:28-29; Revelations 2:20-22)
