

Meeting Minutes from July 8<sup>th</sup>, 2008 Meeting

The new one will include our moose mascot. **Motion by Wayne Higgins to authorize the treasurer to give Darlene a check for \$50.00 at the end of the meeting, seconded by Mike Hanlon.**

Buffy Higgins presented a laminated article to the club for display. The article appeared in the June 2008 Main Sportsman and was written by our club member, Bill Sheldon. Thank you Buffy and thank you Bill!
