Frequency assignments are on a first come/first served basis and will be assigned on a registration payment postmark date basis. All radio conflicts are to be resolved before the regatta, but please bring any additional frequencies/crystals to aid in any last minute conflicts.

Entry deadline is September 01, 2011

Check in: 9:30am to 10:00am October 1st. Check in will be Pond side at Delia park. Boats will be weighed and 2 class measurements may be randomly verified.

Scoring: Low Point scoring method. 3 races minimum.

Racing : One Practice race will be run at approximately 10:00am. Official races will begin thereafter, approximately 10:15 AM. No race will start after 4:00. HMS 2007 will be utilized if needed.

Race Course: 2 times around a Windward leeward course with start and finish to windward will be favored. An offset mark may be positioned approximately four boat lengths from the weather mark. Alternate courses will be set as dictated by wind and weather conditions.

Rules: Races are governed by the current [International Sailing Federation \(ISAF\)](#) Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS) as modified by Appendix E, the prescriptions of US SAILING when they apply, and the rules of the VICTORIA CLASS and the "Sailing Instructions".

- All boats will/must comply with all Class Rules regarding performance criteria.
- Local Rules that non-performance items will not be protestable will be in effect.
- No specific number of shroud lines will be required.
- Local Yacht Club's experienced racers will be on hand as Jury and Judges
- Sail Identification per class rules is required.
