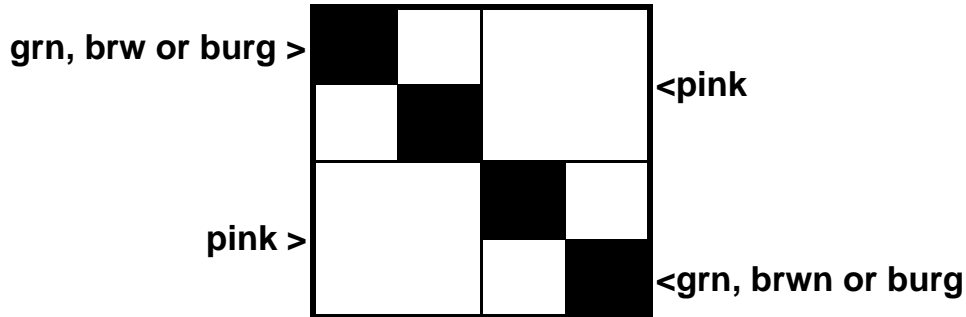

**How Easy Can This Be!!!**

**This super easy block makes an awesome quilt! You see, the super easy but the awesome comes from the color usage and final placement of the blocks.**



**8-1/2" unfinished block**

**(DO NOT SQUARE-THE LUCKY WINNER GETS THAT JOB!)**

**You will need:**

**Light to medium pink prints for background.**

**Contrasting green, brown or burgundy prints for the 4-patches.**

**From the pink print cut:**

**\* 1 - 2-1/2" X 12" strip**

**\* 2 - 4 -1/2" X 4 -1/2" squares**

**From the green, brown or burgundy print cut:**

**\* 1 - 2-1/2" X 12" strip**

**Sew together the 2 - 2-1/2" strips, press open towards the dark fabric, then sub cut to 2-1/2" wide strips. Take two of the sub cuts; position and sew together for one 4 patch. Repeat with remaining 2 sub cuts (these will finish to 4-1/2" square).**

**Lay out and sew the 2 four path units to the pink 4-1/2" squares to form the final block.**

**Note: Make sure the green, brown or burgundy in four patch units run corner to corner of the finished block!**
