SCRAPPY PINWHEELS
DUE AUGUST 27TH, 08 GUILD MEETING

Fabrics needed for one block:

- 7" square cream
- 7" square light brown
- 7" square medium brown
- 7" square dark brown

DIRECTIONS:

Step 1: (Blocks A)

Place cream & medium brown square right sides together.
Draw a diagonal line on cream square and stitch $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam on both sides of the diagonal line.
Cut apart on drawn line.
Press seams open.

(Blocks B)

*Repeat step 1 using light and dark brown drawing the diagonal line on the light brown

Step 2: You now have 2 of block A and 2 of block B.

Place each Block A to a Block B right sides together and matching seams (color placement is your choice).
Draw a diagonal line opposite direction of seam line and stitch $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam on both sides of the drawn line.
Cut apart on drawn line.
Press seams open.

Step 3: Each color will make a pinwheel.

Choose the color you like the best and arrange the four blocks so that there is a pinwheel of the same color in the center and stitch together using a $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam allowance.
Block should measure $11 \frac{7}{8}$ " square.
