MCBA 2008 AGREEMENT OF PARTICIPATION

In order for any band to perform in a MCBA sanctioned contest the band must submit to MCBA the fully executed MCBA 2008 Agreement of Participation form. This form is needed to indemnify MCBA from any litigation brought about by the improper use by the band of copyrighted materials. **The Agreement should be on file at the MCBA office ten (10) days prior to the band's first performance or September 22, 2008, which ever occurs first.**

All high school bands from the State of Michigan receiving any form of feedback from judges — comments and or scores — must be fully paid 2008 MCBA Unit members.

High school bands from without Michigan need not be MCBA members and may compete for awards and placements.

Youth bands and open class bands may perform for comments, but cannot compete for awards or placements.
