**Minutes of the June 12, 2007 meeting, held at the BAC Cafe;**

Joe went over the House Bills and Senate Bills that passed and didn't pass. He explained the impact these bills will have. Joe talked about LPV Approaches (a.k.a. WAAS Approaches) and that Bolivar will have one for 36 in 1-2 years. The FAA has already flown the approach a couple of time to make sure there are no obstructions. AWOS and Super AWOS were discussed and the pros and cons of each. There are not any Super AWOS in Missouri at this time. The extension of Bolivar's runway to 5000' is forthcoming.
