Next July our regular meeting will be with Sebastian Heinz from Mexico, Missouri. We will have deli sandwiches so that more time can be dedicated to Mr. Heinz. Representatives from Piper Aircraft will present our August program.

Scholarship: Don Baker reported that Kevin Barnhouse was in the building. Kevin reported that he is flying 2-3 times a week since moving on to the Cessna 150 with a transfer seat. He has up to 22 hours completed.

New Business: The state meeting in May selected St. Joseph as the location for 2007 and Kansas City in 2006. State membership is declining. We are presently looking at a way to help Duane improve MPA membership.

John Savage is organized a pitch hitter course. George Davis will help with teaching spouses how to use the radios and will present ground school information dealing with Jeppesen materials.
