## Regulations/ Rules For Participants and Spectators

Please read carefully. The premise's owner/ leasee does not guarantee your safety.

We hope you will enjoy the show. Please be happy and safe!

- Age of exhibitor is determined as of January 1, 2004.
- Exhibitors not displaying a entry number will not be placed.
- Current Negative Coggins Required for Horses to be on Property – No Exceptions!
- Stallions are NOT allowed. Yearling or Weanling Colts are allowed to show in Halter/Showmanship
- All passenger vehicles and trucks without trailers are to park in designated parking area.
- Seating is 25 feet away from the outside of the arena. Please be sure chairs are not in the path of moving horses.
- No alcohol is allowed on the premises per ordinance of the City of Peculiar.
- Any dogs being brought on the premises must be on a leash at all times.
- Small children must be under the direct supervision of a parent or guardian. Do not allow children to approach horses without the consent of the owner. Parents are responsible for the activities of their children while on these premises.
- Owners are responsible for their horses at all times.
- If your horse may kick other horses, please obtain a red ribbon at the Entry stand.
- Horses are NOT PERMITTED TO CANTER/LOPE/GALLOP other than within the arena during breaks. Horses are to be kept at either a walk or trot at all times.
- Horses that the horse show committee deems unruly or dangerous to the exhibitor, other horses or exhibitors will be excused from the arena.
- We strongly urge all participants, especially youth to wear protective certified equestrian riding helmets.
- Please dismount from your horse before approaching the Entry/ Announcer Stand.
- Keep within the perimeter of the fenced area. Do not enter the softball field area adjacent to our property. This is off limits.
- Please note the displayed sign concerning Missouri law regarding equine activities.

### Proper Attire:

In-Hand Classes, English Classes or Western Classes:

Shirt with collars

NO T-SHIRTS, TANK TOPS, HALTER TOPS – PROPER UNDER GARMENTS ARE TO BE WORN

Jackets are optional

Slack or Jeans in Western Classes, Breeches, Jodhpurs, Slacks, Tights or Jeans in English Classes—NO SHORTS

Hats are optional

Helmet – All riders are encouraged to wear helmets in English Classes

Boots—Half Chaps are allowed in English Classes—No Tennis shoes, Sandals, Clogs. Tennis shoes made with a heel for riding will be allowed.

Game Classes Shirt or T-Shirt

NO TANK TOPS, HALTER TOPS – PROPER UNDER GARMENTS ARE TO BE WORN

Slacks or Jeans – NO SHORTS

Helmet – All riders under 18 are required to wear helmets. Riders over 18 are encouraged to wear helmets

Boots—No Tennis shoes, Sandals, Clogs. Tennis shoes made with a heel for riding will be allowed.

**Proper Tack:** PTSC shows does not follow any breed or association rules on tack, thus horses may be exhibited in any bit, saddle (Western, English, Australian, etc.). However, all exhibitors must use a saddle (not a "bareback pad") except in the Rotating class—Bareback Pleasure. Any bit that is deemed "severe" or "harsh" will be disallowed. No chain or wire mouth pieces or nosebands.

The Horse Show Committee reserves the right to excuse any exhibitor not wearing correct or unsafe attire or tack.

### High Point Award Rules (Members Only):

The High Point fee will be on One Horse—One Rider. You may nominate as many horses as you wish, however points will not be combined. A nomination form must be filled out for each horse and exhibitor. The fee must be paid prior to the show counting. We will not retro points/shows.

High Point Awards will be given to the High Point and Reserve High Point in each class as well as an over all High Point and Reserve High Point for each age division.
