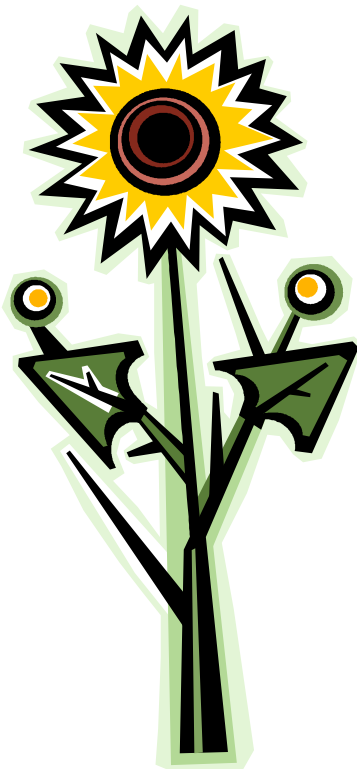
this membership incentive contest will take place at May's general membership meeting. The basket will be on display at this month's meeting. Be sure to check out all the wonderful good-

March's General Membership Meeting will feature a Mardi Gras Murder Mystery Dinner!

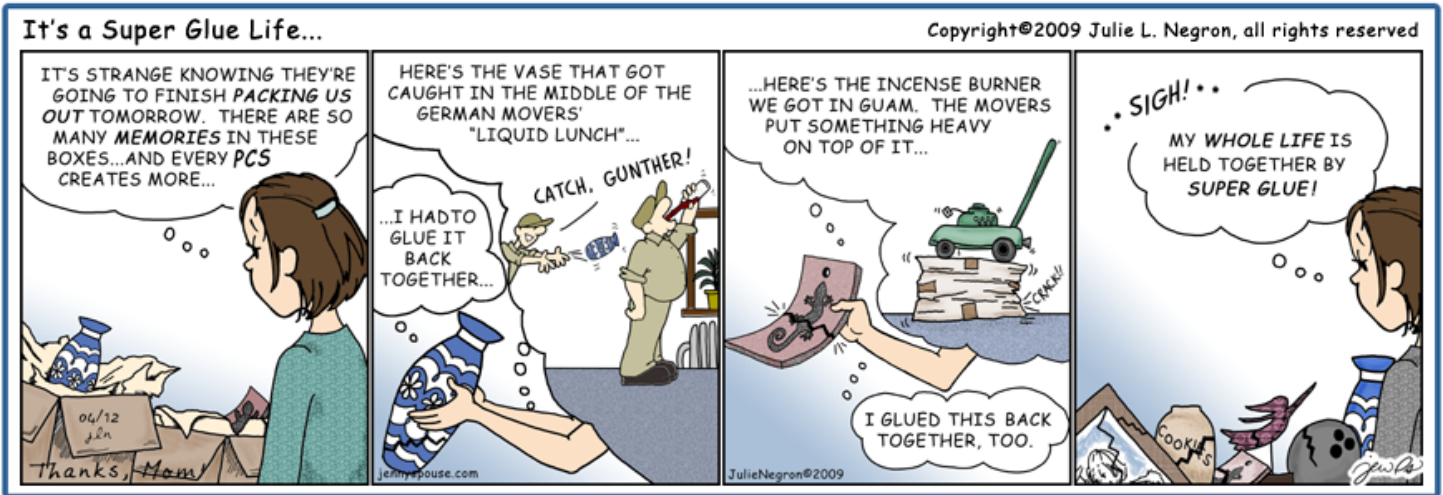
Meet at the Airman and Family Readiness Center (NOT Mission's End) for a potluck dinner at 6:30 on March 15th.
