Wildlife Resources Commission Annual Public Hearing

The Annual Public Hearing dealing with 2010 proposed changes to hunting, fishing and trapping regulations will be held for District 9 at 7 p.m. on Wednesday, January 9th at Southwestern Community College in Sylva.

Among the proposed changes are additions to Public Mountain Trout Waters, a statewide length and creel limit for muskie, a change in squirrel season dates and additions to the game lands program. Meetings will be held across the state in January

by the Commission to invite public comment on the proposed changes.

Fishing proposals include adding Wildcat Lake and almost two miles of Elk Hollow Branch in Avery County and a two-mile portion of the Yadkin River in Caldwell County as designated Public Mountain Trout Waters.
