There will be a total of 15 games and the ticket package to attend all games sells for \$60. There will also be a Banquet at the Holiday Inn during the week and 800 tickets are available for \$35. This is the 4th World Series hosted in Fargo – in 1983, 1992, 1995, and 2009. 1967 was the first year that a ND team played in the World Series. At the Regional level, the host team is able to participate but the ND team must play it's way into the World Series through the Regional Tournament.
