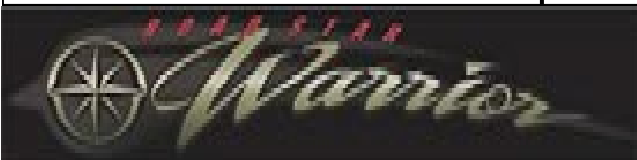

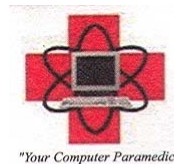

- Turn RIGHT (South) onto Trotter Ln
- Arrive 19 Trotter Ln, Swanzey, NH 03446

From Greenfield

- Depart Greenfield I-91 (North)
- At exit 28A, take Ramp (RIGHT) onto SR-10
- Turn LEFT (North) onto SR-10
