VENTURING - BSA

Wilderness First Aid (WFA) is the assessment of and treatment given to an ill or injured person in a remote environment where definitive care of a physician and/or rapid transport is not readily available. The Boys Scouts of America has partnered with the Emergency Care and Safety Institute (ECSI) and the American College of Orthopedic Surgeons (ACOS) to develop a WFA training curriculum and provide training for Scouters. Venturing Crew 6194 is an ECSI-registered WFA training center. WFA training is required by Philmont, Sea Base, Northern Tier, and other high adventure activities. It is also a valuable skill for all Scouters. Through a series of lectures, demonstrations, discussion, and hands-on skill scenarios participants will learn how to assess, treat, and contain common backcountry emergencies. We will also be offering an optional Adult CPR certification module.

Each course is limited to 24 participants.

Class hours: Saturday & Sunday 9:00 AM to 5:00 PM (not including CPR)

Registration Fee: \$90.00 per person (includes all course materials and a Wilderness First Aid Field Manual)
