Held over two days on two of the most prestigious courses in Northern Nevada - Montreux's Signature Jack Nicklaus Golf Course and Incline Village's Championship Course - Golf fore Education has raised tens of thousands of dollars for scholarships, tutoring, professional development, and educational outreach.

Now in its fourth year, Golf fore Education has become a premier fundraiser for Incline Schools Academic Excellence Foundation (ISAEF), the American Association of University Women--Tahoe/Nevada Branch (AAUW), Project MANA (Making Adequate Nutrition Accessible), and Lake Tahoe School.

Golf fore Education makes a difference!

ISAEF invests \$21,000 annually in tutoring and continuing education

- ISAEF contributed an average of \$33,000 to our endowment fund which now stands at \$140,000.
- Total number of hours tutored annually is 900 hours.

AAUW continues to provide \$12,000 in scholarships for 6 graduating Incline High School Seniors and \$10,000 in scholarships for 7 Incline High School graduates continuing their higher education.

- \$9,200 in grants to the following: Arts for the Schools. Children's Cabinet (Homework Help Club), Pet Network (Children Humane Education Program), UNR Math Camp for an Incline Village Student.

Project MANA works with the schools and community to provide nutrition education. Out work includes "hands-on" nutritional activities with pre-schools and caregivers, second graders,

4th and 5th graders with an after school program called Kids Can Cook, Hunger Awareness Banquets at the middle school, Nutrition snack breaks at the elementary and middle school.

Lake Tahoe School, a PreK-8th grade independent school serving families throughout the Tahoe Basin, provides an intimate and supportive environment for intellectually-motivated students. Teachers work with families to determine an appropriate academically-challenging curriculum for students based on their individual learning styles, their past achievement, and their capacity. In addition to the core subjects of math, language arts, and social studies, all students take science, spanish, music, and art from teachers who specialize in those subjects. Approximately 25% of families receive need-based financial aid from Lake Tahoe School, and funds from Golf fore Education will help ensure that scholarship funding remains a priority.
