Your support of the spay/neuter programs of the Central New York Cat Coalition and other animal welfare agencies prevents the births of millions of unwanted kittens who would face a life of homelessness, sickness and abuse out on the streets. The Central New York Cat Coalition is entirely volunteer- run. We have no physical shelter building or paid staff but in our short history, we have spayed and neutered thousands of cats and kittens, adopted out more than 1,800 animals, and fed and fostered thousands more. We could not operate without:

- ❖ Volunteers and supporters who: staff the PetsMart Adoption Centers; foster cats and kittens and prepare them for adoption; drive cats and kittens to and from clinics and North Shore Animal League (the largest no-kill shelter in the U.S); raise money; deliver cat food; keep our records; answer the phone; schedule spay/neuter appointments; pour beer at SU games (*see below*) and the list goes on and on.
- ❖ Donors who help pay to spay/neuter/vaccinate stray animals and otherwise support our work.
- ❖ The public that trusts us to provide safe and inexpensive spay/neuter services to control the cat population.
